The 5th Opening of the project SIKSHA Labh-3 for the Rotary year 2023-24, under Literacy& Education was at Baranagar Rajkumari Memorial Girls' High School on 16.09.2023 by our Club President Rtn. Kanak Dutt in the presence of our club members. This school was established in the year 1853. It is the oldest school in that area with a huge collection of Books. They also have a 150-year-old rare Bible.

Presently the school has a strength of 1200 students coming from the nearby areas of Baranagar & Dakshineswar. In this project a Computer Lab has been created with an installation of 10 nos. of new Computer Sets along with 10 UPS. The computer lab will benefit around 1200 students with basic computer education every month. The Principal has agreed to allow us to conduct more awareness programme in the school in the coming months.

ATMANIRBHAR 2 — 17 Sep. 2023 - Niharika Handicapped School : AOS — Composite Vocational and New Generations; AOF Composite Growing Local Economies and Supporting Education









The 2nd AATMANIRBHAR Centre was opened on 17 September at Niharika Handicapped School where 80 specially-abled children come on a regular basis for their training and special education. These children come from a distance travelling 30 kms. from Sundarban, Joynagar, Canning, etc. with their mothers as their fathers go out to earn their livelihood. Now, this project will train the mothers in sewing during the time they spend at the centre and another 100 children will learn computers from nearby slum areas of Garia and New Garia. RC Amelia Kolkata will look after the centre day-to-day. The second phase we will

start Adult Literacy for 100 women. This will create a direct impact in the society. Thanks to President, Hony. Secretary, PDG Prabir Chatterjee, Rtn. Sonia Dutt and Shaswati Roy Chowdhury for being present in the program. Thanks to all the donors also.

ATMANIRBHAR 3 – 23 Sep. 2023 – RCC Ranihati, Netaji Samaj Sathi : AOS – Composite Vocational and New Generations; AOF Composite Growing Local Economies and Supporting Education













Rotary Club Calcutta has started the Vocational Centre at RCC Ranihati, Netaji Samaj Sathi 3 years back in a very small way with a Tailoring Unit and a small computer centre. Now the RCC and RC Calcutta dedicated the entire newly constructed building for an entire Vocational Service Centre with 60 women working and 40 new women getting new training, making a total of 100 women getting empowered. Today the Centre was opened at the ATMANIRBHAR Centre for women with 30 new sewing machines and 11 new Computers for Digital Education and Computer Training. The women are making garments which they displayed today with so much joy, and selling their creation in the local market. The sewing teacher said that the entire village knows her as SELAI DIDI -- what a joy and a successful

story. Today we were so confident with them that clubs every year during Durga Puja, purchase clothes for puja gifts for village children, purchase order for 700 shirts and pants, and 700 salwar suits was placed on them. Clothes will be supplied by club, and the women will stich and make it ready – a source of small income before the festive season. A small example of "Creating Hope in the World".
