Dr. Amrita Panda is a Rehabilitation Psychologist registered with Rehabilitation Council of India, holding a PhD in Experimental Rehabilitation Psychology from Department of Psychology, University of Calcutta. She was in academic research in the field of special needs for the primary years of her career, travelling across the globe presenting research papers at all top tier Psychology conferences. She shifted to clinical practice and administrative role in the second half of her career with the zeal to bring in measurable changes in the quality of life of special needs individuals in our country. She served a pioneer institution of Eastern India as an administrative head with





250 children and adults with autism over 6 years. In 2022 she founded her own non-profit company Deep Ranjani Foundation focusing primarily on vocational training and employment opportunities of special needs adults, thereby ensuring their life satisfaction. Her specialization in designing Psychometric Assessment Tools and Data Analytics along with her clinical experience and extensive training in psychotherapeutic methods has empowered her with the unique blend of academia and field work in the arena of special needs over last 16 years. She has also dedicated 20 years in bringing up her dream organization Paramparik to the height where thousands of physically and psychologically underprivileged people got opportunity of free education, medical treatment, sand rehabilitation. Presently she is also a member of Skill Development Committee, Bengal Chamber of Commerce & Industries.

STUDENT CONCLAVE – ROTARY SADAN 10 OCT. 2023 : AOS – NEW GENERATIONS; AOF – PROMOTING PEACE

















The Rotary Club of Calcutta, in association with the Youth Service Committee, organised a **Student Conclave on Peace building and Embodied Leadership** on October 10th, 2023, at Rotary Sadan. In this conclave, nine schools from Kolkata and its suburbs participated, naming a few: St. Xavier's Collegiate School, La Martiniere for Boys, The Heritage, Serampore Girls' High School and many more. From each school, a team of 2 students (Class VIII-XII) spoke on the topic: **Meeting the challenges of peace in the VUCA World for** 7 minutes, with each speaker speaking for the same duration of time. The modality of the oral presentation was provided in the invitation letters sent to the schools.

VUCA is an acronym coined in the year 1987, based on the leadership theories of Warren Bennis and Burt Nanus to signify Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, and Ambiguity. Since then, VUCA has been used within the modern contexts of leadership and other fields to describe volatile, uncertain, complex, and ambiguous environments. The premise of this conclave was to assess the perception and opinions of young minds in adopting leadership skills to foster peace, harmony and hope in a changing and unpredictable environment.

The program commenced with the national anthem led by Rtn. Ruchika Majumdar, followed by a welcome speech from Rtn. Dr. Saswati Mukherjee, Chairperson of the Youth Service Committee. During her speech, she explained the purpose of organising this student conclave. The Chief Guest, District Governor Hira Lal Yadav, Guest of honour, District Interact Committee Chair Rtn Apala Dutta, Rtn Rajani Mukherjee, Member of Rotary India Literacy Mission, and the Rotarian judges were felicitated. President Rtn. Kanak Dutt addressed the audience, followed by brief addresses by DG Hira Lal Yadav, Rtn Apala Dutta and Rtn Rajani Mukherjee.

The oral presentation was impeccably executed. The participants did adequate research on the topic and delivered splendid performances, which were an absolute delight to witness.

Rtn. Dr Suman Mukherjee was the session chair, whose outstanding moderation and erudite remarks enriched the knowledge base of the participants and added a prevailing outreach to the event. The judges, which included Rtn. Dr. Suman Mukherjee, Rtn. Dr. Krishna Sen and Rtn. Dr. Chandrayee Das had the tough task of selecting the winning team.

The team from St. Xavier's Collegiate School secured first place and was awarded with a gold medal, and La Martiniere for Boys came in second, awarded with a silver medal. The best speaker awards went to Mahadevi Birla World Academy and Serampore Girls' High School. Lastly, all participants received certificates for their efforts. The conclave concluded with a vote of thanks from R-Ann Sucharita Roychowdhury. Food boxes were provided to the participants, teachers, student audience and Rotarians; tea and refreshments were also served.
