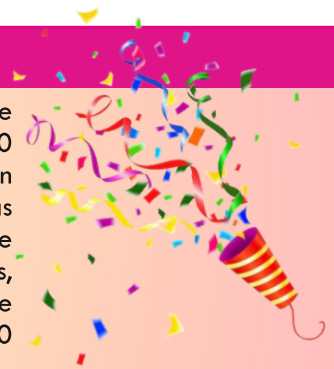

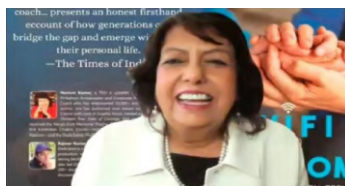
Physical Health Initiative: June 20, 2025
