
On 10th December, Investor Awareness Program was co hosted at the playground of local club of Mahajati Kalyan Samity, Ruby Park, Kasba.



December. Sports goods worth Rs 25,000 were distributed amongst the children. Project chair Rtn Jully Sharma sponsored the program.
















