

## **INTERACT CLUB REPORT FY 2024**

- May 2024, 2024: We participated in the Champ for Life seminar on mental health at Rotary Sadan . This seminar emphasized the importance of mental health, especially for young people, and equipped our members with valuable insights into resilience and emotional well-being. It was a significant initiative for us, as mental health awareness continues to be a critical issue among students.
- June 23rd June 24th , 2024: We attended Sambardhan, the annual meeting of the Interact Club, where we had the opportunity to network with other clubs and learn from their experiences. Shortly after, on June 24th, two of our members, along with our teacher, Ms. Nidhi Agarwal, were felicitated. This recognition was a proud moment for us.
- June 28th, 2024: One of our key projects this year was the donation drive for Chunkha Bari Balika Vidyalaya. We collected and donated essential items such as sanitary napkins, books, pencil cases, stationery, sattu, cookies, and other supplies to the school. This drive aimed to support the education and personal needs of the students, particularly young girls who often lack access to basic necessities. The success of this initiative reinforced the importance of helping educational institutions, especially those serving underprivileged communities.
- July 13th, 2024: We launched an ongoing project to feed stray dogs in collaboration with an NGO. This initiative has continued to grow, with more students volunteering to feed stray animals in different areas of the city. It has become one of our most successful long-term projects, raising awareness about animal welfare and fostering compassion among students for stray animals.
- Second week of July, 2024: Additionally, in the second week of July, we visited Jyotirmoy School, an NGO that works with

underprivileged children. Our members spent time teaching and interacting with Class One students, providing them with basic education and engaging them in fun activities. This visit was a valuable learning experience for our members, helping them understand the importance of education and community support.

July also saw our annual school fest, Interface, a fest with a cause, tied up with the Interact club. All proceeds from the fest were donated to an old age home in Midnapore through the NGO Pukaar.

- August 17th , 2024: We sent another installment of donations to the same old age home, including about 96 children's clothes,75 sarees, umbrellas, shoes, toys, napkins, stationery, and nutritional items. These donations provided much-needed relief to the elderly residents, furthering our commitment to supporting vulnerable communities.
- September 28th , 2024: The BSS School, in collaboration with the Calcutta Debating Circle and other institutions, held a Dyslexia Awareness Workshop at Rotary Sadan, focusing on supporting neurodiversity. The event began with a symbolic 15-minute walk, honoring the resilience of individuals with Dyslexia. Esteemed speakers, including Menon Mukherjee, Professor Debasree Banerjee, and Dr. Arundhuti Sarkar, led sessions on Dyslexia's challenges, early signs, and inclusive teaching strategies. Engaging discussions dispelled misconceptions, bridging urban-rural awareness gaps and encouraging open dialogue for a more inclusive educational approach.
- October 2nd , 2024: We geared up with a flood relief drive in response to the devastating floods in our state. We collaborated with Pukar to send ten cartons of edible relief, including puffed rice, biscuits, chana, cakes, and other dry snacks, to the affected areas. This initiative al-

lowed us to offer timely assistance to those in need, reflecting the club's readiness to respond to emergencies.

- October 29th, 2024: The Interact Club held its first fundraiser on the school premises, where we sold handmade savouries to gather funds. The response from our fellow students was truly heartwarming, as they generously supported our cause. The funds collected were used to buy festive gifts for the children of Jyotirmoy School, a place for underprivileged students, allowing us to share a little joy and celebration with them for the upcoming children's day celebration.
- November 14th, 2024: We visited Jyotirmoy School to bring joy to underprivileged children. We distributed packets of biriyani, spoons, and napkins, and gifted them pencil bags filled with stationery, making their day special. The experience was truly heartwarming, and we felt grateful to have been a part of it. Spending time with the kids brought us inner peace and happiness, and seeing their faces light up with joy was the best gift we could have received on Children's Day, making it a truly unforgettable experience.

Late November, 2024: The Interact Club organized a successful Winter Clothes Drive to collect warm clothing for individuals in need during the winter season. Students from classes 6 to 11 participated enthusiastically, donating jackets, sweaters, scarves, gloves, and blankets for all age groups. The drive received an overwhelming response, with students showing great generosity in supporting the cause. The Interact Club members worked diligently to sort and organize the donations. This initiative not only helped those facing the challenges of the cold weather but also fostered a sense of community spirit and social responsibility among the students.

■ 15th December, 2024: We had the

privilege of attending "Care-nival 2.0," a Christmas carnival hosted by Dr. P. Banerjee Homeopathic Research Clinic for specially abled children. The children showcased their talents through poetry, singing, and dancing performances, leaving us stunned. We distributed chocolates, food packets, and gifts, feeling grateful for the experience. ■ 20th December, 2024: The BSS School organized a joyful Christmas drive at Jyotirmoy School, sponsored by Swayam Bhar. The children received colorful books and crayons to spark their creativity.
