Together, let us continue creating impact, nurturing hope, and proving that Service Above Self is not just our motto, but our way of life.



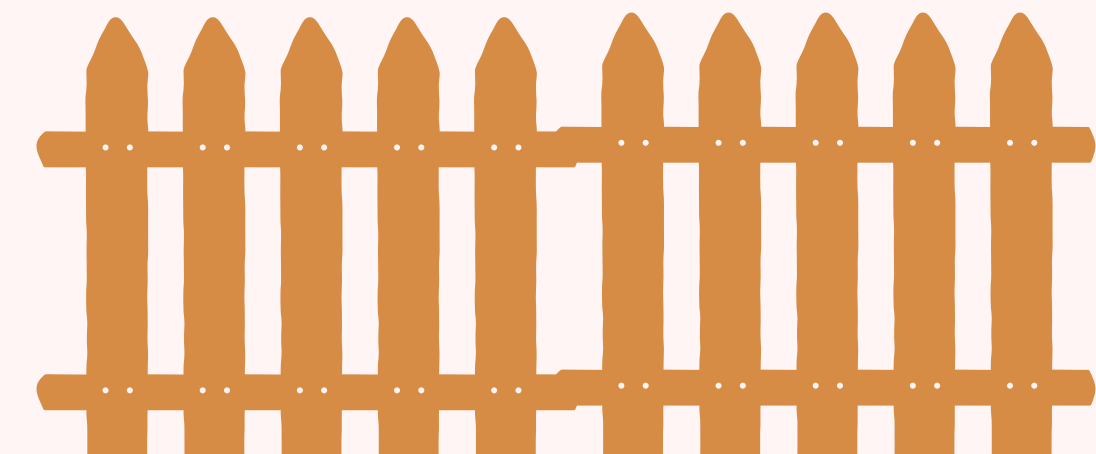


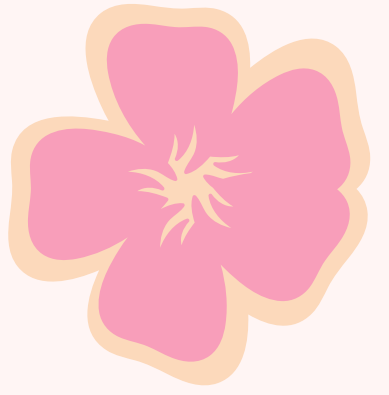
WOMENS DAY CELEBRATION

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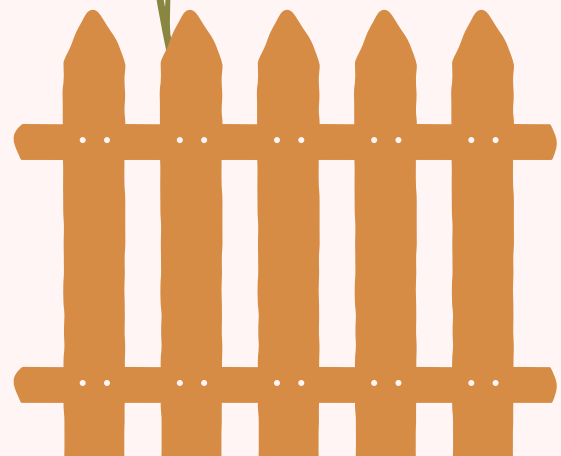




TOXICITY TO TENACITY

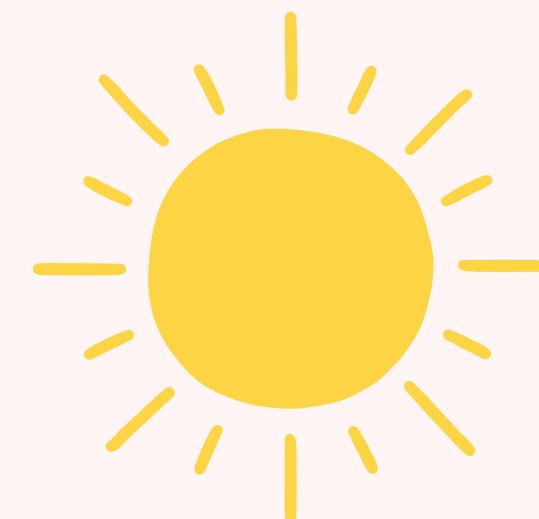
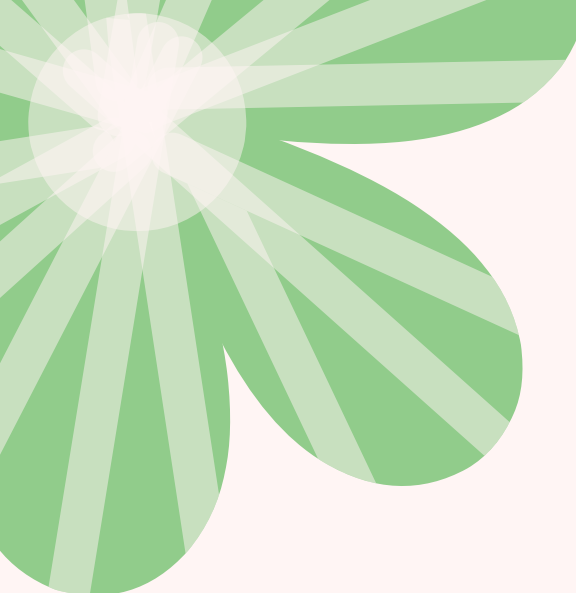


PRAVESH URJA

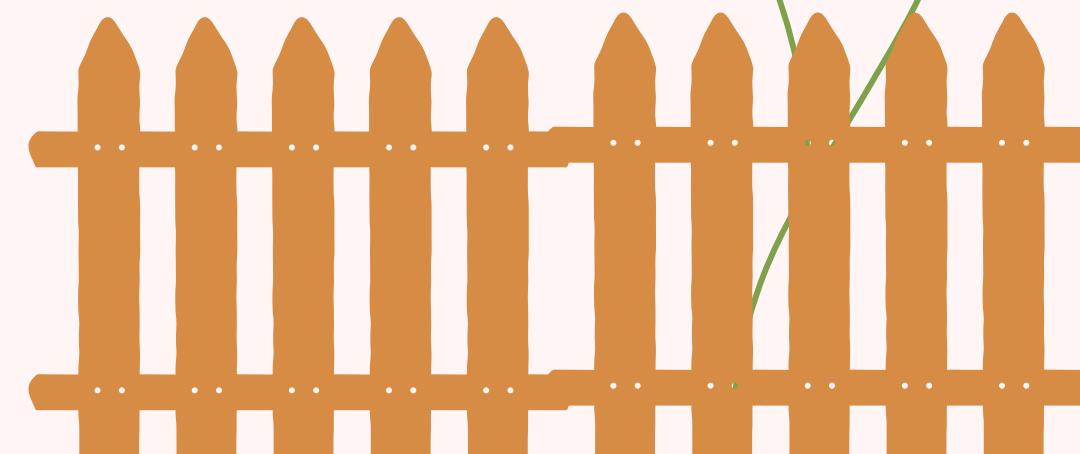


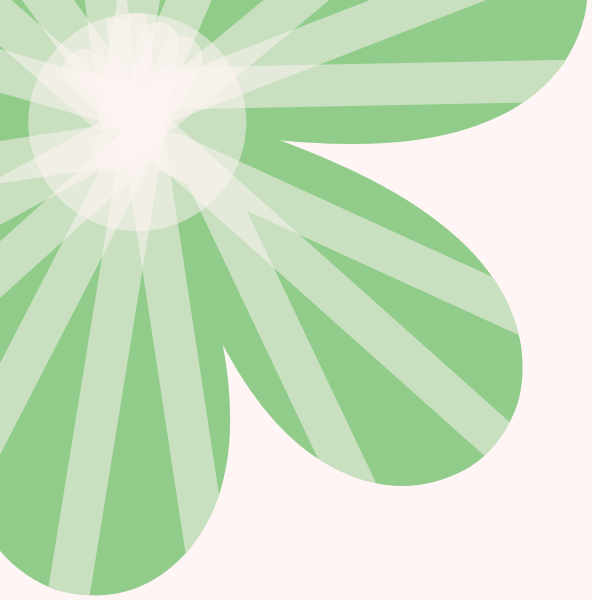
OFFICIAL CLUB VISIT
