

Visit to Ekwaipally Village

The RCHN team recently visited Ekwaipally village, a community grappling with significant challenges related to access to safe drinking water. The lack of a reliable and clean water source has left the villagers struggling to meet their daily hydration needs, which is crucial for their health and well-being.

During our visit, we met with the village Sarpanch, who expressed deep concerns about the ongoing water crisis. He highlighted the urgent need for a sustainable solution and requested assistance from the Rotary Club of Hyderabad North. Specifically, he proposed the installation of a reverse osmosis (RO) plant at the designated premises of the Gram Panchayat. This RO plant would serve as a vital resource, providing the villagers with free access to purified drinking water.

The installation of this facility would not only address the immediate water scarcity issues but also promote better health and hygiene practices within the community, ultimately improving the quality of life for all residents of Ekwaipally.

The school principal and faculty expressed their happiness and gratitude for these much-needed developments in the school.














Meeting with Singareni Collieries CMD

On September 23, 2025, representatives from the Rotary Club of Hyderabad North visited the Singareni Collieries Company Limited (SCCL) to meet with the Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) regarding the release of pending Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds. A total amount of ₹3,00,000 had been previously sanctioned, with a remaining balance of ₹150,000 still pending disbursement.

During the meeting, we presented letters, photographs, and detailed accounts of the expenditures incurred. The CMD responded favorably to our request. Additionally, our Director of Service Projects, Rtn. P. Ramanamurthy also sought reimbursement for expenses personally incurred by Rtn. Sagi Srinivas. The CMD assured us of support and expressed a positive stance on the release of this amount, bringing the total to ₹3,74,000.

This initiative encompassed the construction of a washing area, toilets with a septic tank, and overhead tanks on the school premises, with a total expenditure of approximately ₹7,00,000.
