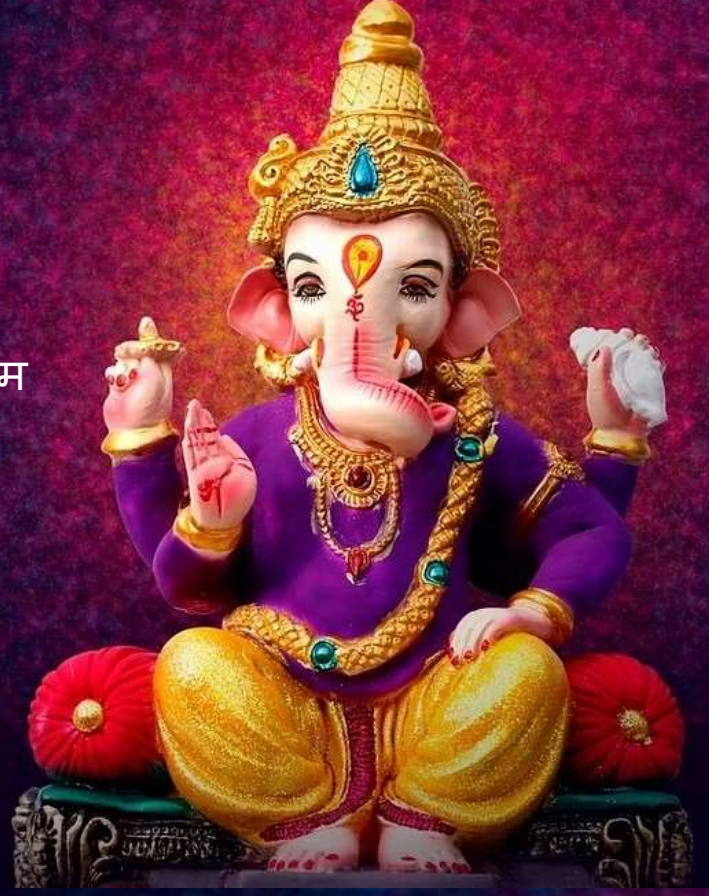

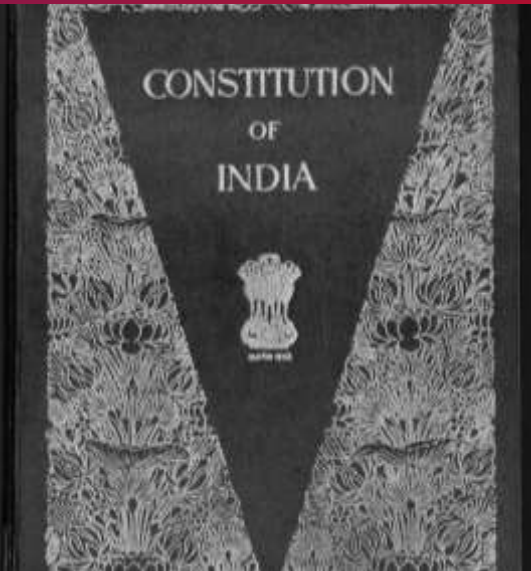


THE INDIAN CONSTITUTION

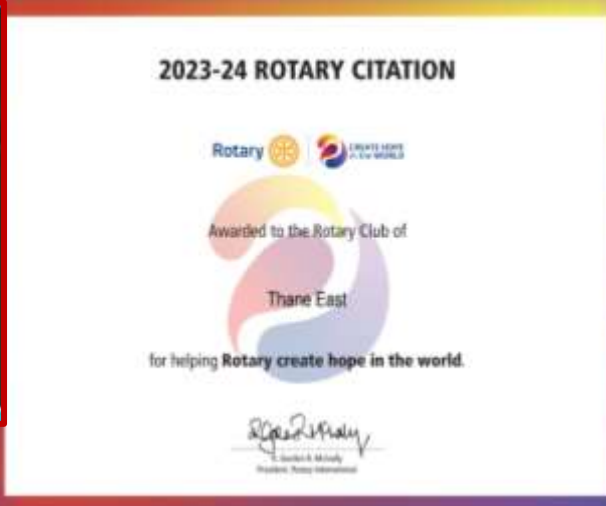
