 - Rotarians involved: 15


All attendees were arrived on time at 5:30 a.m. and President Rtn. Atul Daptardar and Rtn. Geetanajli Daptardar were present for the event.







6. WEEK-04 – 24.10.2025 MEETING – 17 – POLIO AWARENESS RALLY




Highlights of the Rally:

- •Rotarians gathered at Vishrambag Chowk by 7 AM, ready for the ride.
- •Participants rode bicycles and two-wheelers along the route from Vishrambag Chowk to the **Ram mandir**.
- •Everyone wore **polio-themed T-shirts**, symbolizing unity and the global message to eliminate polio.
- •During the rally, Rotarians distributed informational pamphlets to the public, spoke about the importance of polio vaccination, and engaged with local citizens to encourage support.
- •The presence of Rotary members in uniform with the "End Polio Now" logo helped draw attention and spark conversations in the community.
- •World Polio Day on 24 October was established by Rotary International to honor the birth of Dr. Jonas Salk, who led the development of the first polio vaccine.
- •This day is widely used by Rotary clubs worldwide to mobilize action, celebrate achievements, and raise awareness about eradication efforts.


