Till 1985, I was working as an Business Executive traveling extensively in India and abroad and I had limited local contacts. So when I started a small scale unit, I had to do everything by myself right from getting Xerox copies to replacing my scooter tyre. Once I happened to visit a tyre shop run by Rtn. Hemadi and saw the 4-way test displayed there. I was impressed by it and asked him whether I can join Rotary. Without a moment's hesitation, he said Rotary membership is by invitation and you don't qualify for that. After 12 years, Rtn. Mohan Gargate invited me to join Rotary and I became a Rotarian from July 1996. Thus this is my 30th year in RCK.

When I became President in 2008-09, my agenda was to bring down average age of our club by at least 5 years from then 64 years and I achieved it. I also organized District TRF seminar at Shivaji University in Nov 2008 and got record registration from whole District. PRIP K R Ravindran was the chief Guest. I received many awards including Best President and Best Club. In 2011-12, as only Asst Governor for all all clubs in Kolhapur, we were first in giving TRF donations. I tried my hand at becoming DG for 2016-17, but withdrew as I understood my limitations to have late evening meetings everyday. Then I took more interest in RSSK and was its President for 4 years and managed to complete our iconic building in-spite of many hurdles. I am the only third level major Donor to TRF from our club. I love Rotary and respect it for the management education and team building it teaches to all Rotarians. Long live Rotary and its motto of service above self.

Rotary Foundation and Rotary Foundation (India): Driving Change Since 1917

The Rotary Foundation (TRF) has spent over \$4 billion globally on sustainable projects that improve health, education, and economic development since its founding more than 100 years ago. In India, TRF works through Rotary Foundation (India) [RF(I)], a registered society since 1988 providing donors 50% tax exemption under Section 80G and fulfilling requirements to implement Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) projects through Ministry of Corporate Affairs registration.

RF(I) has completed over 3,375 projects valued at \$1.5 billion across key focus areas and partnered with nearly 400 corporate donors. In 2024–25, India contributed nearly \$32 million to TRF, becoming the world's second-largest donor.

Rotary's mission to create lasting community impact continues through initiatives like a \$2 million water conservation project aiding over 60,000 farmers across four Indian states, alongside efforts to eradicate polio and promote peace worldwide.

Together, TRF and RF(I) embody "Service Above Self," transforming lives globally and in India.
