Vishalgad - The Fort of Valour

About 75 km from Kolhapur lies **Vishalgad**, a fort that lives up to its name—"The Grand Fort." This fort played a vital role in Maratha history, especially during the escape of **Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj from Panhala to Vishalgad**. The journey and the subsequent battle at Pavan Khind immortalized the loyalty and sacrifice of Maratha warriors.

Vishalgad, with its strategic location overlooking the Konkan coast and the Deccan plateau, was a

stronghold that connected trade and defense routes. The fort houses several noteworthy sites such as **Amruteshwar Temple**, **Sati Vrindavan**, and ancient structures that reflect the architectural brilliance of the time.

Even today, Vishalgad attracts history lovers, trekkers, and devotees who come to pay respect at places where legends were created. Standing on its ramparts, with cool mountain winds and breathtaking views, one can almost hear the echoes of war cries and sense the courage of the Marathas who defended their land with unmatched valor.


