Know your Rotary



District Designated Funds (DDF)

District Designated Funds (DDF) in Rotary are funds that a district receives from the Rotary Foundation, based on a portion of the contributions made by Rotary clubs and members to the Annual Fund. These funds can be used for various district and club projects, such as funding local district grants, contributing to global grants and scholarships, supporting PolioPlus, or other initiatives. The district leadership, including the District Governor and the District Rotary Foundation Chair, decides how the DDF is allocated and grants them to projects based on district priorities and applications.



Allocation and use of DDF

- District Grants: Districts can use up to half of their DDF to fund district grants for shortterm humanitarian projects in a local community. These grants may also include vocational scholarships.
- Global Grants: DDF can be used to provide matching funds for global grants, which are larger-scale international projects.
- Other programs: The remainder of the DDF can be used for programs like PolioPlus, Rotary Peace Centers, or other district-specific projects.
- **Rollover:** There may be limits on how long a district can roll over unused DDF, so districts are encouraged to use them to make an impact.
