





Congratulations AYAN


A Proud Achievement in Science

Shri Ambeshwar Devrai, Ambla

Shri Ambeshwar Devrai, Ambla (Tal. Shahuwadi, Dist. Kolhapur) is considered one of the largest and oldest sacred groves in Maharashtra. Located in the Sahyadri mountain range, this devrai is known for its dense forest, centuries-old trees, rare medicinal plants, and a wide variety of birds and animals. Due to the strong faith and traditions of local people, cutting trees, hunting, or harming nature is strictly prohibited here. As a result, the devrai has been preserved in its natural form. It is a beautiful place where environmental conservation, biodiversity, and religious belief come together.



At the heart of the devrai stands the Shri Ambeshwar Temple, the main place of worship in this area. This ancient temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva (Ambeshwar) and is an important spiritual center. Special prayers and rituals are held during Mahashivratri and the Shravan month, when a large number of devotees visit the temple. The Ambeshwar Devrai and temple are about 60–65 km from Kolhapur city, near the Ambla Ghat region. One can easily reach the place by car, bus, or taxi via the Kolhapur → Ambla Ghat → Ambla route. The monsoon and winter seasons are the best times to visit. Visitors are expected to follow nature rules and keep the area clean.

Ambeshwar Devrai is not only a religious or tourist place but is also closely connected to local culture and daily life. Villagers organize traditional festivals, worship, and service activities every year. The peaceful surroundings, sound of birds, flowing streams, and mist-covered greenery during the monsoon give deep mental peace. For nature lovers, researchers, environmentalists, and devotees, this devrai is an ideal destination and a source of inspiration that teaches the importance of protecting nature for future generations.
