## Kolhapuri saaj

### Heritage gold necklace of Kolhapur

Kolhapuri Saaj is a traditional gold necklace from Kolhapur district of Maharashtra and is an important part of Maharashtrian culture. The word “Saaj” means necklace, and Kolhapuri Saaj is known for its distinctive design, religious symbolism, and cultural value.

The necklace usually consists of 21 gold pendants, called “paane”, strung together with gold beads. Each pendant has a unique shape and represents different deities, symbols, and aspects of life. Common motifs include Goddess Lakshmi, Lord Vishnu, the sun, the moon, flowers, and auspicious symbols. These pendants are believed to bring prosperity, protection, and good fortune to the wearer.

Traditionally, Kolhapuri Saaj is made from pure gold and crafted by skilled local artisans using age-old techniques. It is heavier than modern necklaces, which reflects its royal and traditional nature. Earlier, it was commonly worn by women from royal families and later became popular among common people, especially in rural Maharashtra.

Kolhapuri Saaj holds great importance during weddings, festivals, and religious ceremonies. It is often gifted to brides as a symbol of prosperity, marital happiness, and cultural pride. Even today, wearing Kolhapuri Saaj with a traditional Nauvari saree completes the authentic Maharashtrian look.

In modern times, while lighter and redesigned versions are available, the traditional Kolhapuri Saaj continues to be cherished as a symbol of Maharashtra’s rich cultural heritage. It represents not just jewellery, but history, faith, and identity passed down through generations.
