# Hearing Test and Hearing Aid Camp

Date: 10th & 11 th January 2026

Venue : Rotary Samaj Seva Kendra, Kolhapur



A Hearing Loss Diagnosis and Hearing Aid Testing Camp was successfully organised by the Rotary Club of Kolhapur, under the aegis of Rotary Samaj Seva Kendra, through the Rotary Speech and Hearing Centre, on Saturday, 10th and Sunday, 11th January 2026. The inaugural function on Saturday was graced by the Chief Guests **Dr. Ajit Lokare**, President, ENT Association, and **Dr. Vinayak Raikar**, Secretary, who formally inaugurated the camp by lighting the ceremonial lamp. The occasion was further dignified by the presence of **Rtn. Pradeep Karande**, President and **Rtn. Nilesh Kutte**, Secretary, Rotary Club of Kolhapur;

**Rtn. Arvind Krishnan**, Secretary, Rotary Samaj Seva Kendra; **Rtn. Dr. Abhijeet Haval**, Chairman, Rotary Speech and Hearing Centre; **Dr. Santosh Kulkarni**; and Rotary members - Rtn. The two-day camp received an overwhelming response and was conducted very smoothly with the dedicated support of ENT specialists **Dr. Vinayak Raykar**, **Dr. Ganesh Taralekar**, **Dr. Santosh Kulkarni**, and **Dr. Ujjwala Kolekar**. A total of 215 patients were registered, out of which 125 patients underwent audiometry tests. During the camp, 22 hearing aids were fitted and sold, while nearly 25 additional hearing aids were booked, ensuring continued follow-up care. The initiative will continue to benefit patients for the next eight days, as many are expected to visit the centre for further evaluation and hearing aid support. Overall, the camp stood as a remarkable example of Rotary's sustained commitment to improving hearing health and enhancing the quality of life in the community.

## Dajipur Wildlife Sanctuary

### - A Natural Treasure of the Western Ghats


Dajipur is a small village located in Kolhapur district of Maharashtra, approximately 490 km from Mumbai and about 40 km from Radhanagari. It lies in the Sahyadri (Western Ghats) mountain range, close to the road connecting NH-17 (now NH-66) with Kolhapur. The region is well known for its rich natural heritage and spiritual significance, especially the Dajipur Wildlife Sanctuary and the revered Gagangiri Maharaj of Gaganbawda.

The Dajipur Wildlife Sanctuary, also known as the Bison Sanctuary, is a protected area spread over approximately 120 sq. km. Established in 1985, the sanctuary was created to conserve the biodiversity of the Western Ghats, with special focus on the Indian bison (Gaur), the flagship species of the sanctuary.

The sanctuary is home to a diverse range of wildlife, including leopards, sloth bears, wild boars, sambar deer, barking deer, giant squirrels, and numerous species of birds, making it a paradise for nature lovers and wildlife enthusiasts. Dense evergreen and semi-evergreen forests, scenic valleys, waterfalls, and natural streams add to its breathtaking beauty.

Visitors can enjoy jeep safaris to observe wildlife in their natural habitat or explore the forest through guided nature trails and treks. Basic accommodation facilities are also available for tourists wishing to stay overnight and experience the serenity of the forest.
