

WEEK 6: नागपंचमी

नागपंचमी (संस्कृत: नागपंचमी, IAST: Nāgapañcamī) हा नाग (najas) किंवा साप (जे पौराणिक नाग प्राण्यांशी संबंधित आहेत) यांच्या पारंपारिक पूजेचा दिवस आहे. भारत आणि नेपाळ या देशात हा सण साजरा केला जातो .

हिंदू पंचांगानुसार श्रावण महिन्याच्या शुक्ल पक्षाच्या पाचव्या दिवशी (जुलै/ऑगस्ट) ही पूजा केली जाते. कर्नाटक, राजस्थान, बिहार आणि गुजरात सारखी काही भारतीय राज्ये त्याच महिन्याच्या कृष्ण पक्षाला नाग पंचमी साजरी करतात. उत्सवाचा एक भाग म्हणून, चांदी, दगड, लाकूड िकंवा चित्रापासून बनवलेल्या नाग िकंवा सर्प देवतेला दुधाने आदरपूर्वक स्नान िकंवा अभिषेक केले जाते आणि कुटुंबाच्या कल्याणासाठी त्यांचे आशीर्वाद मागितले जातात. या दिवशी जिवंत सापांची, विशेषतः नागांची, पूजा करण्याची पद्धती प्रचलित असल्याचे दिसते. कालिया नागाचा पराभव करून यमुना नदीच्या पात्रातून भगवान श्रीकृष्ण सुरक्षित वर आले तो दिवस श्रावण शुद्ध पंचमीचा होता. त्यामुळे त्या दिवसापासून नागपूजा प्रचारात आली असे मानले जाते.

दर बारा वर्षांनी नागपंचमीच्या दिवशी देशभरातील नाथ संप्रदायाचे लोक गंगा-गौतमी (अहिल्या-गौतमी) संगमावर स्नान करतात.



President-Nominee of Rotary International for 2027-28

Rtn. Larry A. Lunsford, a longtime member of the Rotary Club of Kansas City-Plaza, Missouri, USA, has been named president-nominee of Rotary International for 2027-28. A dedicated Rotarian since 1991, he has served as district governor, RI director, and trustee of The Rotary Foundation. Lunsford has chaired key Rotary and Foundation committees, including the Executive Committee and Finance Committee.

His Rotary journey began as a recipient of a Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholarship in 1981-82, which enabled him to study at the University of Newcastle, Australia. He holds bachelor's and master's degrees in accounting from Truman State University, which later honored him with its Distinguished Service Award.


