

Every Rotarian is therefore invited and encouraged to support the Annual Fund with a personal contribution, Every Year.





GOALS OF LIFE

What is the right time to set goals in life? when asked the question to a group of individuals they answered as "NEW YEAR"

Most of us take up New Year Resolution as our Year's Goal. We jot down, we plan, we declare on that very day ..but is it truly the right time...? The answer is "NO", the right time is "NOW".

Now, when you have the pinch in the stomach to achieve something in the right time. But did you know that there is a method to achieve your goals? or when to choose your goals.

Your goals should be SMART, hence are called SMART GOALS where-

- S** - stands for **Specific**
- M** - stands for **Measurable**
- A** - stands for **Achievable**
- R** - stands for **Relevant**
- T** - stands for **Time Bound**

Let us take an example: Let's say Goal of Weight Loss

- Rather than saying, I want to loose my weight, you need to define it. Specifically, like – I want to lose my weight for my 21st birthday, so that I can fit my desired red dress. This gives me the clear picture of self by visualization.
- The goal should be measurable – In case of weight loss, you need to define the number of kgs or inches, you want to lose like I want to lose 10 Kgs.
- It should be achievable, losing 10 kgs in next 3 months is achievable but losing 10 kgs in 1 week is simply not. If you set achievable goals without considering your capacity or inner strength, you will encounter failure which will give you negative feedbacks without achievements.
- Your goals should be relevant to the situation you are facing right now or might face in future. For example- you want to lose weight because you don't want to suffer like your father who had diabetes and had to amputee his leg.
- And the last is time bound, putting your goals in frame of time, gives you direction and motivation. Example of Loosing weight of 10 kgs in 3 months.
