## Robin Hood Army Kolkata Serves 500+ Tribal Families in Shantiniketan on Republic Day

As part of the initiative, RHA Kolkata distributed essential grain kits to over 500 tribal families. 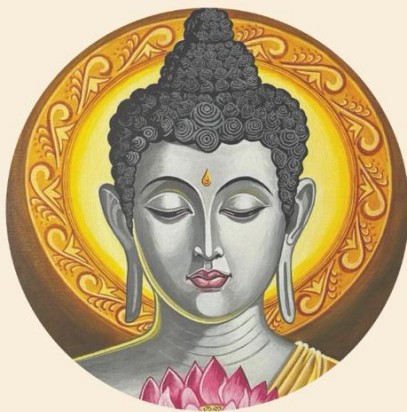
