VISIT TO RCC AT USTHI

President Tunir Chakravarti along with few other Rotarians of Innercity visited Bharat Tirtha Vidyapeeth, a recognized Primary School at our RCC at Usthi on 24th November, 2024. They were given 4(four) sewing machines and advised to give training on tailoring to the willing girls and boys of the village so that they can become self reliant by making a living out of this. They were also given 2(two) desk top computers for the benefit of the students of the school.



AWARENESS PROGRAM ON CERVICAL CANCER & SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED DISEASES IN RED LIGHT AREA AT BOWBAZAR

The red light areas are the most vulnerable places for sexually transmitted diseases. Rotary Club of Calcutta Innercity in association with Durbar Mahila Samanoy Committee and Kolkata Municipal Corporation organised an awareness program on prevention of Cervical Cancer and sexually transmitted diseases at Prem Chandra Boral Street Red Light Area at Bowbazar on 25th November, 2024 at 3.00 pm. Dr. Sujata Dutta, Senior Gynoecologist and a member of the Innercity family, addressed the assembly of about 50 sex workers and explained the symptons, causes and prevention of cervical cancer amongst women and stressed on the need to take vaccination against cervical cancer at the appropriate time, ie. between 13 and 19 years of age. Two doses of the vaccination is a must for effectiveness. She also laid stress on getting a PAP smear test done every 3 to 5 years to detect cancer or any other sexually transmitted disease for older women.

President Tunir Chakravarty urged everyone to take advantage of this initiative and register the names of interested persons with Durbar for the vaccination, which will be administered free of cost to the recipients by Rotary Club of Kolkata Innercity.
