MINUTES OF THE 1361ST RWM & CLUB ASSEMBLY WITH AG VISIT HELD ON 4TH APRIL, 2025 AT AHUJA ART MUSEUM, KOLKATA

- President Rtn. Tunir Chakravarti calls the 1361st RWM to order and requests all members to rise for the National 1. Anthem led by Rtn. Swapna Bhattacharya. Minutes of the 1360th meeting is confirmed. Inner Voice also circulated.

- President welcomes Rtn. Vikram Tantia, Assistant Governor & Rtn. Raj Kumar Agarwal, Zonal Secretary to the 3. club meeting. PDG Nayantara Pal Chowdhury felicitates both the guests by presentation of *uttorio* and mementos.
- LOA is granted to Rtn. Noshir Framjee, Rtn. Bikramjit Ghosh, Rtn. Rakhee Biswas, Rtn. Subhasis Ghosh and Rtn. 4. Anindya Pal Chaudhury.
- President reports on the project on 'Celebrating International Transgender Day of Visibility' held on 31st March 5. 2025 at Rotary Sadan from 6.00 -8.00 pm. The program was attended by about 10 members of Inner City. It was organized by Gokhale Road Bandhan and Association of Transgender, Hijra in Bengal in collaboration with our Club. Dignitaries like Smt. Rupa Ganguly, Smt. Agnimitra Pal, Shri Shanti Das Basak, Shri Sabyasachi Chatterjee, etc. were present.
- President announces an upcoming project on 6th April at Ved Vigyan Maha Vidyapeeth, Geeta Bhawan, Shastitola, 6. Unsani, Howrah, a rehabilitation home for drug addicts founded by Art of Living where the club will donate a water storage tank.
- President requests all members to be present with their spouses for the next RWM on 26th April, 2025 and visit of 7. our District Governor, Rtn. Dr. Krishnendu Gupta at 12 noon at Calcutta Club. 3 new members will be inducted on that day.
- Secretary conducts club business. 8.
- President invites the Assistant Governor & Zonal Secretary to the top table. 9.

Minutes of the 1361 RWM (2)

- 1. Rtn. Vikram Tantia welcomes all to the club assembly. Based on the reports during the last 9 months, he remarks that commendable and innovative work has been done by the club. His observations are:
- i) Inner City is a 49 members club with 3 members added and 3 more likely to be inducted soon. Therefore, there will be a growth of about 10% which is appreciable.
- j) Main area of concern is contribution to the Foundation. Till now, no contribution has been made to the Polio Plus Fund and only USD 500 has been contributed to the Annual Fund from this club. He requests all members to contribute in the last quarter to the tune of at least USD 5000 collectively.
- k) Polio has become a major concern this year with 99 cases reported in the 2 neighboring countries. As Rotarians, we have to see that every club does something on Polio eradication and contributes USD 500-1000 towards the Polio Fund.
- About 35-40% members of Inner City are still unregistered in My Rotary website. Efforts should be made to register all members.
- m) As per OCV Report submitted, the club has done 35 service projects and 5 vocational projects. He suggests that focus areas should be chosen and 3/5 projects highlighted like project on Sex Workers, Transgenders which is unique in district 3291. He also advises that such projects may be sent for coverage in the Rotary News.
- n) EIRWTF can be used for undertaking projects in the next 3 months.
- o) Encourages joint meetings and joint projects with other clubs and collaboration with bigger clubs for Global Grant projects.
- p) Congratulates the President, Secretary and all members for great projects and great reporting.
- 1. Rtn. Raj Kumar Agarwal says that most of points have been covered by the AG and he has nothing further to add. However, he suggests that Inner City should become a full PHF club and requests contribution to the TRF.
- 2. 18 members, 2 guests are present.
- 3. The sunshine collection is Rs. 700.
- 4. The meeting ends with greetings to Rotary Club of Calcutta and Rotary Club of Calcutta Chowringhee and thanks to all members present.
