





I wish all the best, and together as a team, we have the power and the magic to change lives. Let us be motivated, inspired and encouraged



Dr. Malini is a Professor and Chairman in Departments of Zoology, Genetics and Genomics in the University of Mysore. Has a Doctoral Thesis on "Genetic Disorders". She has 23 years of vast experience.

Her specialization is on 'Human Genetics' 'Cytogenetics' and 'Andrology'.

Currently, she has EIGHT Phd students under her guidance. SEVEN, trained by her, have obtained Phds. She has presented over 80 conference papers, published 74 lab papers and conducted 10 refresher courses.



She has completed the following 'Mural Projects'.

- Molecular analysis of Male Infertility in Mysuru; funded by the UGC.
- Ŗ Bio Anthropological, Bio Chemical and Bio Ethnical Study of 'Tribals' in Western Ghats.
- Analysis of the effects of 'Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus' on male fertility funded by Indian Council of Medical Research.
- Radio Protective Evaluations of Omega 3 fatty on 'Reproductive Fitness'.

### Margadarshak Awardee - Dr. S.N.Hegde

Dr. S.N.Hegde is an highly accomplished personality. He has a PHD in DIROSOPHILA GENETICS form the University of Mysore. In his 37 years of rich experience he has guided 18 students to successfully completing their PHD. He has over 130 publications to his credit, He has authored 33 books and penned over 600 articles. Post retirement he was appointed as the Controller of examinations at Yuvarajas College from 2013 to 16. He has served the University Grants Commission, Zoo Authority of Karnataka and various other nodal organizations. He is a recipient of various awards nationally and Internationally. His lifetime achievements include editing of Encyclopedia on Zoology for the University of Mysore. He has published a Dictionary of Biology translated into Kannada which is a first of its kind of work. Presently he is writing biographies of all 'Nobel Laureates' in the fields of Physiology and Medicine.

## "ROTARY DIALYSIS CENTER - OUR SIGNATURE PROJECT" OUR PRIDE IN COORDINATING EFFORTS WITH ROTARY CHAMARAJANAGAR.



DNA of our club lies in our ESP; 'Extra Sensory Perception'. That is to walk that 'Extra Mile' in identifying projects that have public reach and can function in perpetuity. One such is our Signature Project, the "Dialysis Center"; functioning extremely well at Chamarajanagar.



**'Bangalore Kidney Foundation'** offered help to our club to establish a center at Mysuru. Knowing that Mysuru has adequate facilities spread across the city, we gave it to Rotary Chamarajanagar. Inhibitions, apprehensions, limitations and complexes were set aside with the belief – "Where There is a Will, There is a Way". Donations close to **Rs. SIXTY LAKHS** have been received, to date. Since inception in 21 – 22 Rotary Year, more than 2000 treatments have taken place at "Kshema Hospital"; owned by PDG Dr. Nagarjun; a "Stop Gap" arrangement. Average total cost per treatment is Rs. 950.00. In most cases, costs are subsidized by 50%. Utterly poor patients are treated free of cost also.

Currently, we are in the process of building our own center at 'Rotary Bhawan, Chamarajanagar'. Architectural and Engineering services are being provided by consultants from Mysuru. A "TRUST" is registered exclusively to fund and manage the functioning of the center. A 'Bank Account' has been opened and is operational currently.



#### MEGA MUSICAL NITE – OUR FUND RAISING PROGRAM.

On Sunday, the 23<sup>rd</sup> of April, 23, our club staged a 'Mega Musical Nite' by our own Rtn. V. N. Prasad and Troupe at the renowned Karnataka Kalamandira Auditorium, Mysuru. Iconic classical duets like "KuhooKuhoo Bole Koyala"; "Ajhun Na Aye Baalma"; "JanemanJaneman Tere Do Nayan"; "MangKeSathTumhara"; "Tumhari Nazar Kyon Kafa Hogayi"; "Intihaan Hogayi Intzar KI" etc were sung—to the delight of the audience.

Elite audience attended the program; that became 'Talk of the Town'. Guests of honor at the program were the family of legendary late Mohammed Rafi – Daughter, Mrs. Nasreen Ahmad; Son in Law, Mr. Meraj Ahmad, Grand Daughter Firdus Imran, her Husband Mr. Imran. They were highly appreciative of the program.

Entry was free of cost. However, floor collection and donations from well-wishers amounted to over Rs. One Lakh; applauded at the Joint Board Meeting of the club held on the 18.06.2023.

An amount of Rs. Thirty Thousand was donated to the 'Palliative Care Unit' of Swamy Vivekananda Youth Movement'.
