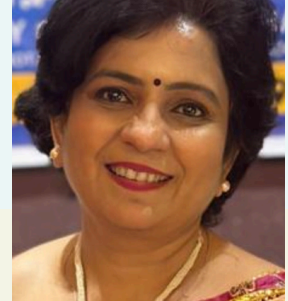

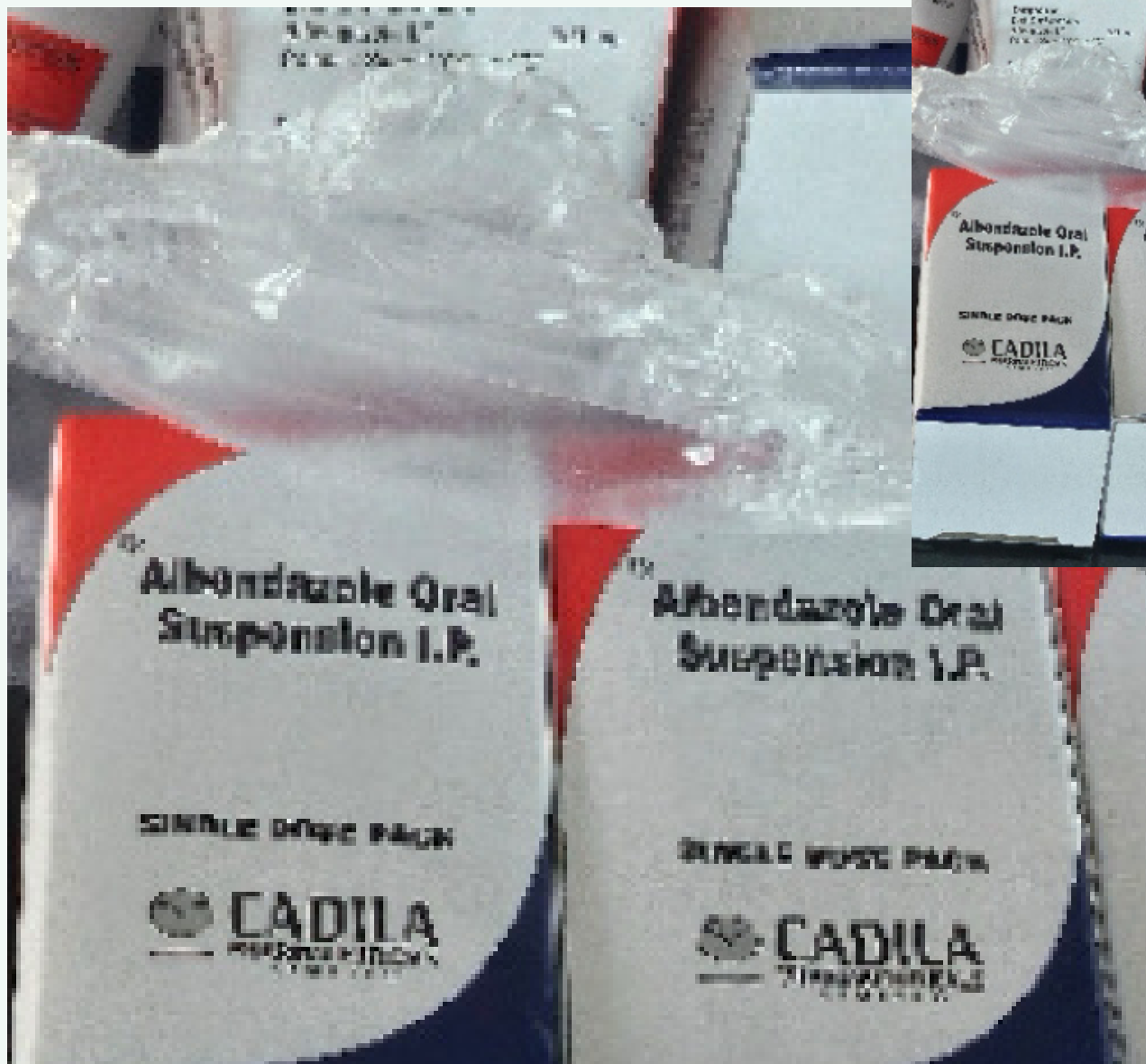

The response was heartwarming, reflecting the positive impact of the initiative. This effort reinforces **Rotary's dedication to environmental sustainability and women's well-being.**

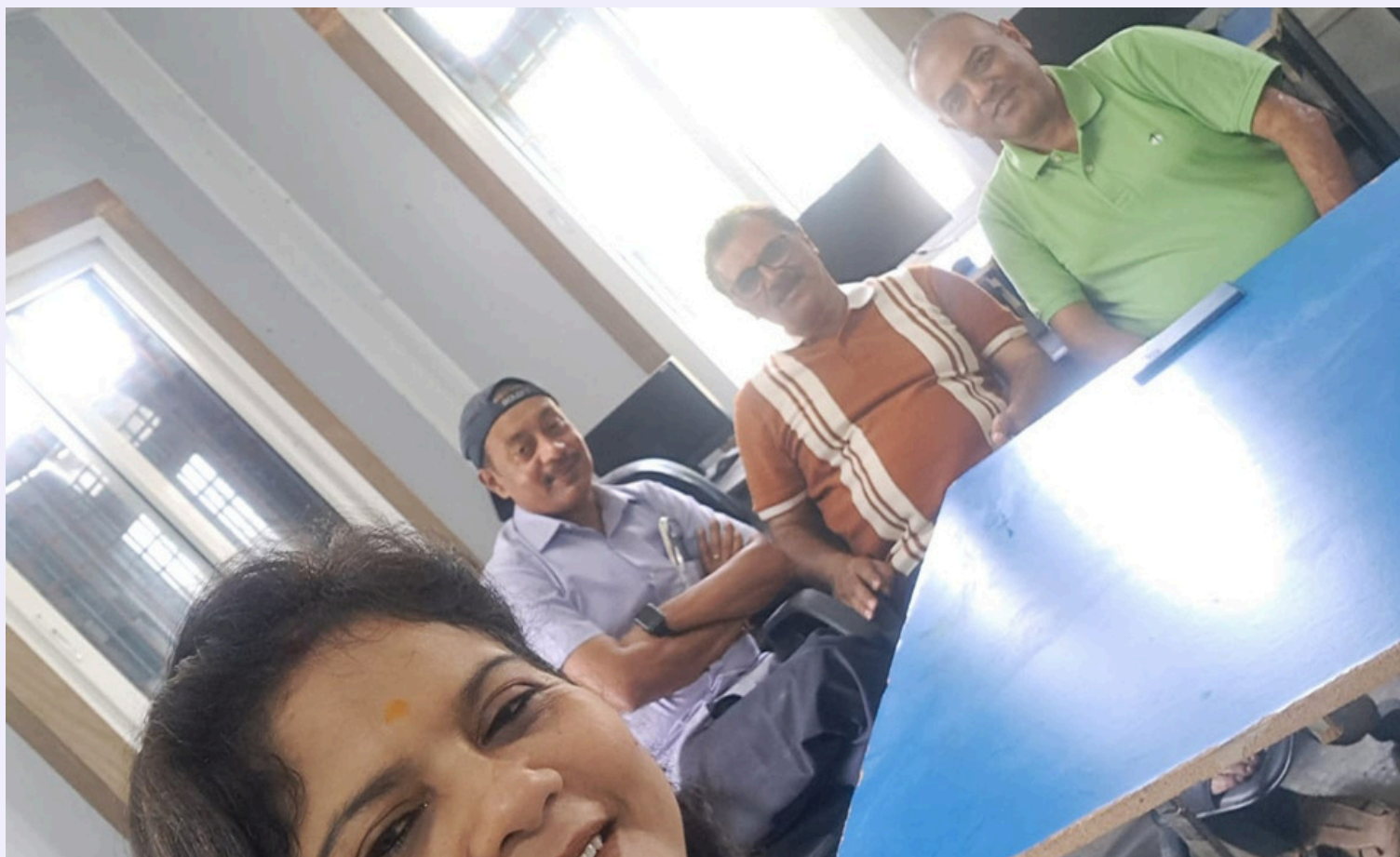
Deworming Initiative
