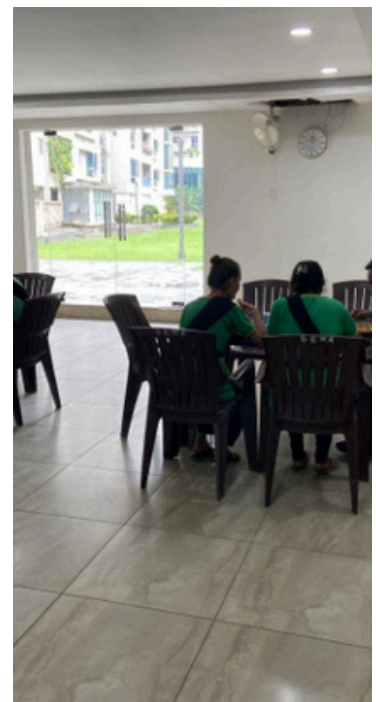

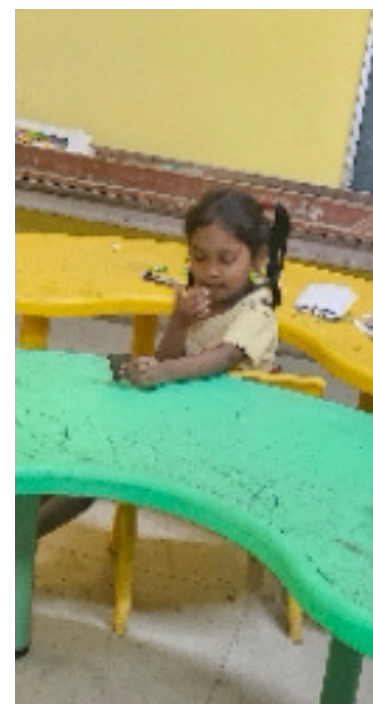

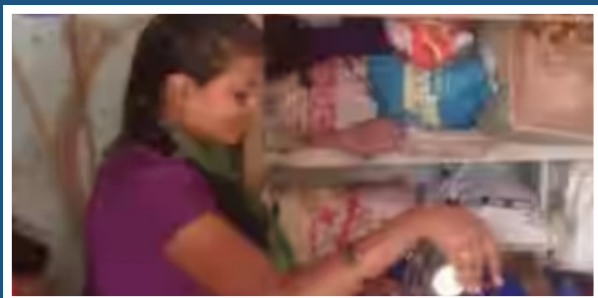
VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRES

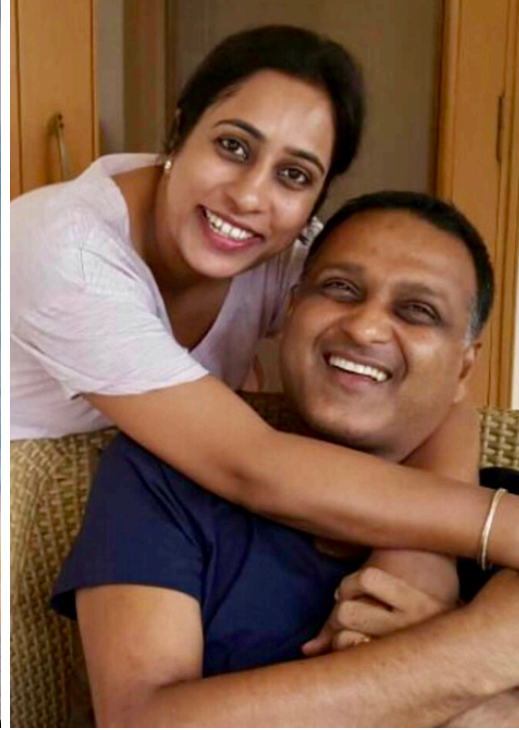
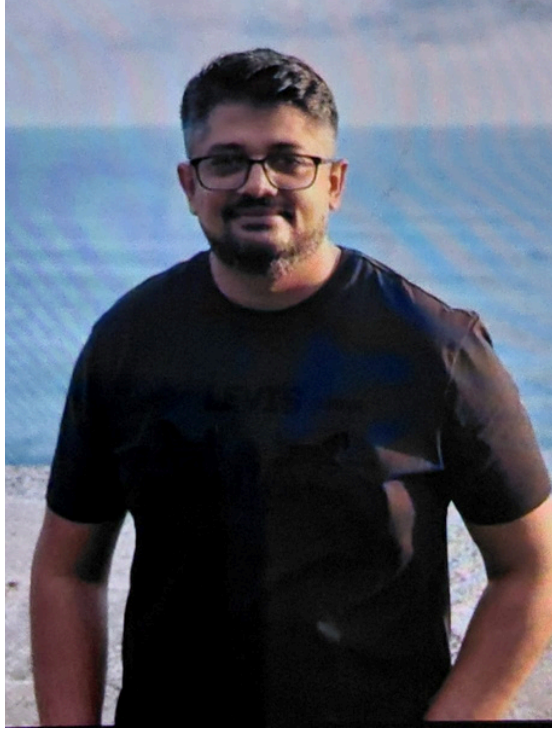

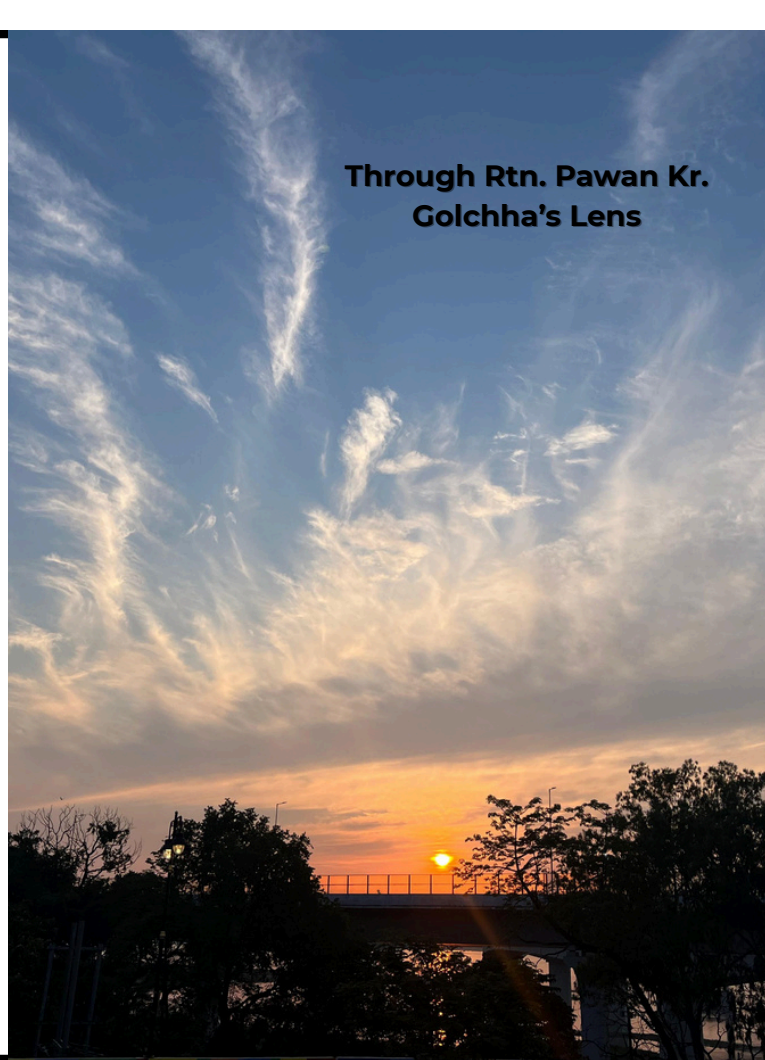
