



#### Introduction:

Since its founding in Jan'1983, the Rotary Club of Hosur which is a 100% PHF club now, has been a cornerstone of positive change, enriching the lives of people in the region with its unwavering commitment to service. Over the past 43 years, the club has not only grown in strength but also in the scale and impact of its community efforts. Guided by the Rotary International motto, "Service Above Self," the club has continually addressed the evolving needs of the community through key projects in healthcare, education and civic infrastructure.

#### A Visionary Beginning:

The journey of the Rotary Club of Hosur began when a group of visionary individuals recognized the need for an organized force for good in the rapidly growing industrial town of Hosur.

Diversified classification of member is the main strength of our club. Spearheaded by Shri MG Rajaram, IAS, also the Charter President, the club was officially chartered on 19.01.1983 under the banner of Rotary International. It is a multi-linguistic club wherein majority of members speak multi local languages viz., Tamil, Telugu, Kannada, Malayalam, Hindi etc. In its initial years, the club focused on small yet impact initiatives, from health camps to educational support, laying a strong foundation for future growth.

Club not only had a distinction of having highest contribution to TRF but also had a proud member Rtn Perumal GPT who paid entire USD 25000 in one lot to become the first Endowment Donor from the club, first in the Zone and first in the District. Further, club has produced one DG, Rtn Major Donor S Raghavan for the RY 2023-24.

#### Signature Projects: Defining Our Legacy:

One of the defining aspects of the Rotary Club of Hosur has been its long-standing signature projects, many of which have become pillars of community support and care.

### **Eye Camp – 35 Years of Restoring Vision:**

A hallmark of the club's service, the annual Eye Camp has

been serving the underprivileged for nearly four decades. Thousands of people have benefited from free eye screenings, cataract surgeries and corrective treatments. This initiative has restored vision to many, empowering them to lead more fulfilling lives. The Eye Camp has become synonymous with the club's dedication to healthcare access.

#### **Crematorium Maintenance:**

Recognizing the importance of maintaining a dignified resting place for

the departed, the club took on the responsibility of overseeing the local crematorium's upkeep. This project, which has been in place for several years, ensures that the facility remains clean, functional, and respectful for families during times of grief. Our club played a significant role during the Covid period. Hundreds of bodies were cremated free of cost as a part of our commitment to society.

#### Healthcare and Global Grants: Broadening the Impact

The Rotary Club of Hosur in association with its sibling clubs has successfully executed many Global and District Grants projects which are highlighted in the below paragrahs. Rotary International's Global Grants to spearhead life-changing healthcare projects in the community, demonstrating the club's commitment to creating lasting impact. Participation in internationally funded projects that brought advanced medical equipment and resources to local hospitals.

#### Dialysis Unit at the Government Hospital, Hosur:

In partnership with global Rotary Clubs, the club established a Dialysis Unit at Hosur's Government Hospital, a critical facility for patients suffering from chronic kidney diseases. The unit provides essential dialysis services to those in need, free of cost, greatly improving access to life-saving treatments for economically disadvantaged individuals.

#### **Neonatal Care Unit:**

The club's Neonatal Care Unit at the Government Hospital, Denkanikottai is another milestone, focusing on reducing infant mortality by providing state-of-the-art medical equipment and care for newborns. This unit has become vital to ensuring that newborns receive the highest level of care during their critical early days.

#### **Blood Bank Upgradation:**

Through the blood bank upgradation project which is in pipeline, the club has determined to enhance the local blood bank's capacity, ensuring that lifesaving blood supplies are readily available to meet emergency and routine medical needs. This initiative definitely will save countless lives, reinforcing the club's commitment to healthcare advancement.

### A Journey of Growth: Milestones Over the Decades

The Rotary Club of Hosur's journey over the past four decades has been marked by significant milestones and an ever-expanding vision for community service.

As a part of Environment conservation, plantation drives, awareness campaigns on water conservation and clean-up projects became a regular feature. Proud to say that Rotary club of Hosur used to host GSE (Group Study Exchange) members.

The past decade has been a period of consolidation and sustained impact. The Rotary Club of Hosur embarked on ambitious projects that addressed the evolving needs of the community, such as Health care, Crematorium maintenance etc.
