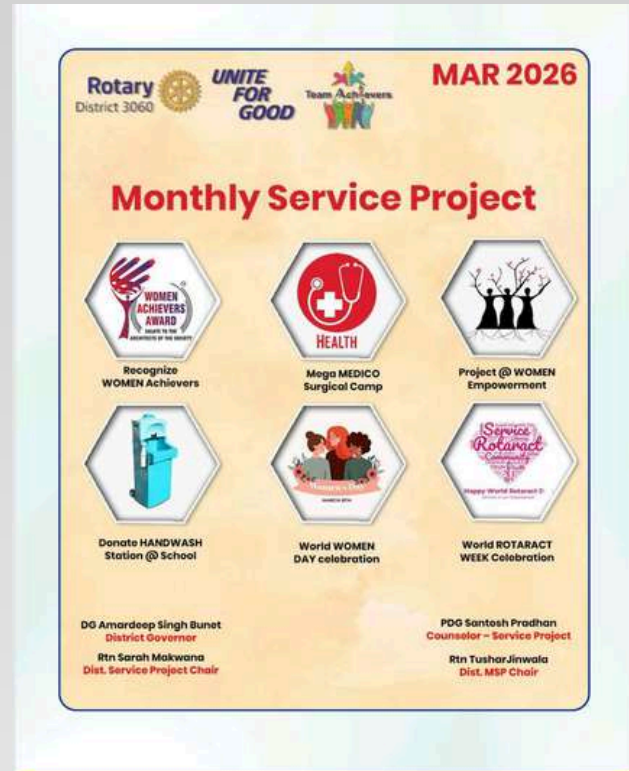
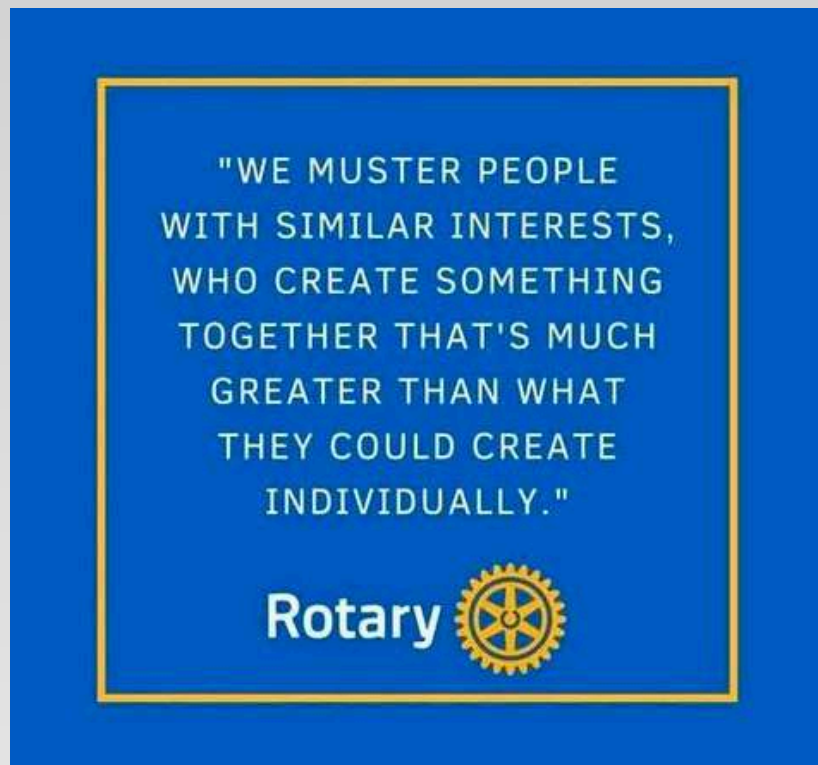

1962: Interact - a program for youth

The first Interact club is certified on 5 November, 1962 at Melbourne High School, in Florida, USA. Interact empowers students in intermediate and secondary school to learn leadership skills.

1965: Grants support service projects

The Foundation begins supporting club and district projects with matching grants, the first regular program to fund these service efforts.

1965: Group Study Exchange

Through the Group Study Exchange program, teams of young business professionals visit each others countries to learn their culture and gain business insights. Today the tradition continues through vocational training teams.

1968: Rotaract targets young adults

Rotary certifies its first Rotaract club at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte in the U.S. Rotaract is created as a program for college-age students and young professional, but in 2019 Rotaract clubs are redefined as a unique type of membership in Rotary.

1971: Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)

Rotary adopts the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA). Events teach secondary school students through young professionals leadership, communication, and problem solving skills.

1975: Rotary Youth Exchange

Rotary clubs have been facilitating student exchanges since the 1920s. In 1975, Rotary recognizes Rotary Youth Exchange as an official program administered by clubs and districts.

1978: Health, Hunger and Humanity grants

Rotary develops a program to improve health, alleviate hunger, and enhance human and social development. Rotary members use the grants to create access to clean drinking water, support literacy programs, provide medical care, and more — setting the stage for today's global grants.



RI President Clem Renouf announce the 3-H program at the 1978 convention in Tokyo: "A new program will be launched during this coming year . . . which will bring a new dimension to our service activities. It will be known as the Health, Hunger and Humanity program."

1979: Rotary International fights polio

A multi-year grant project to immunize children in the Philippines launches Rotary in the fight to eradicate polio.



On 29 September 1979, RI President James L. Bomar Jr. ceremonially launched the project in the Philippines by administering oral polio vaccine to a child in Guadalupe Viejo in metropolitan Manila.

Rotary Club of Amreli Gir successfully organized a ticketed devotional show Shiv Shabad on 10th February at Dilip Sanghani Sanskrutik Auditorium, Amreli. The program beautifully portrayed the life, teachings, and divine miracles of Lord Shiva through soulful music, devotional songs, and bhajans, creating a spiritually uplifting atmosphere for the audience.

The event received an overwhelming response with a houseful audience of more than 550 viewers. The performance conveyed valuable life lessons inspired by the principles and teachings of Lord Shiva, leaving the audience deeply inspired and spiritually connected.

The success of this event was the result of 18 days of dedicated planning and promotion, including active marketing through social media and various community outreach platforms. Apart from providing a memorable devotional experience to the public, the program also significantly enhanced the public image of Rotary

Audiology Speech Therapy Center

The advanced Audiology and Speech Therapy Center was established through a Global Grant from The Rotary Foundation (Grant No. GG#2125937). This center is designed to provide diagnosis and treatment for hearing and speech-related difficulties for individuals ranging from newborns to 75 years of age. The project is operated at Shree Bera Munga School in Amreli, and received financial support of ₹28 lakhs from Rotary Club of Emory Druid Hills (USA) and RI District 3060. This initiative falls under Rotary's Disease Prevention and Treatment area of focus, with the vision to help the people of Amreli district become free from deafness in the coming years.



Club's Permanent Projects...

Miyawaki Forests

The club has developed two mini forests within the campus of Bera Munga School. While the traditional plantation method allows for only 80 to 100 trees in a given area, the Miyawaki technique makes it possible to plant over 350 trees in the same space. In both of these Miyawaki forests developed by the club, a variety of medicinal, fruit-bearing, and bird-friendly native trees have been planted. This method allows trees to grow naturally within just 12 to 18 months, creating an environment similar to a small jungle. Established under Rotary's "Supporting the Environment" area of focus, this forest not only sustains the environment but also serves as a source of learning and environmental awareness for students.



Rotary Library at Devaliya

The Club proudly operates a Rotary Library at GKP Village Devaliya – a space dedicated to nurturing learning and curiosity among students, children, and adults of the entire village. This free and open-access library houses a rich collection of over 520 books, covering a wide range of subjects to support academic learning, self-development, and general knowledge. The initiative aims to foster a culture of reading and lifelong learning in rural communities. It has significantly contributed to enhancing the public image of Rotary, showcasing our club's commitment to sustainable and impactful service. Rotary Library is not just a project – it is a quiet revolution in empowering minds and expanding horizons.

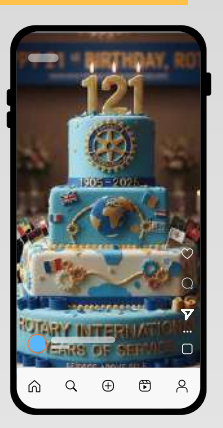
