Know your Rotary International President 2024-2025



Stephanie A. Urchick (President 2024-25, Rotary Club of McMurray, Pennsylvania, USA) Stephanie A. Urchick has been an RI director and Rotary Foundation trustee and has served Rotary in numerous capacities, including as training leader, regional Rotary Foundation coordinator, and RI president's representative. In addition, Urchick was a representative and member-at-large at three sessions of the Council on Legislation.

Urchick has also served as chair of the Strategic Planning Committee and The Rotary Foundation's Centennial Celebration Committee, as well as a member of various Rotary committees, including the Election Review Committee and Operational Review Committee.

A Rotary member since 1991, Urchick has participated in a variety of international service projects, including National Immunization Days in India and Nigeria. In Vietnam, she worked with clubs to help build a primary school and traveled to the Dominican Republic to install water filters. A student of several Slavic languages, she has mentored new Rotary members in Ukraine and coordinated a Rotary Foundation grant for mammography equipment and a biopsy unit for a hospital in Poland. In its commemorative book, the Rotary Club of Krakow, Poland, noted Urchick as a key figure for helping the rebirth of Rotary in post-Communist Poland. Urchick has also helped to pair clubs and districts in the U.S. with Rotary clubs in Albania, Kosovo, and Ukraine for humanitarian and educational services.

Urchick's professional background is in the higher education, consulting, and entertainment industries. She received her doctorate degree in Leadership Studies from Indiana University of Pennsylvania and has been recognized by The Rotary Foundation and numerous community and international organizations.

Urchick asks members to champion Rotary's Action Plan so they can improve their clubs and keep Rotary strong, find a balance between continuity and change, and work for peace. She also emphasizes the continuing importance of the effort to eradicate polio. She urges members to join or initiate PolioPlus Societies in their districts and do all they can to help end the disease. Urchick will lead the 2025 Rotary Presidential Peace Conference in Istanbul, Turkey, 20-22 February 2025, with the theme Healing in a Divided World.

Know your Rotary International's president for 2026-27



Sangkoo Yun, of the Rotary Club of Sae Hanyang, Seoul, Korea, is the selection of the nominating committee to become Rotary International's president for 2026-27. He will be officially declared the president-nominee on 15 September if no other candidates challenge him. Yun received his bachelor's and master's degrees from the Syracuse University School of Architecture in the U.S. and an honorary doctoral degree from The University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He is the founder and CEO of Dongsuh Corp., which engineers and markets architectural materials, and the president of Youngan Corp., which operates in real estate and financial investment. He is involved in many civic organizations and has a special interest in the preservation of cultural heritage. A Rotary member since 1987, when he was a charter member of the Rotary Club of Sae Hanyang, Yun has served Rotary International as a director, trustee, committee member and chair, and RI learning facilitator. He served for eight years as co-chair of the Keep Mongolia Green Project, by Korean members of Rotary. His RI committee roles include the Board Administration Committee (2013-15, vice chair 2014-15), the International Assembly Committee (vice chair, 2020-21), and the End Polio Now Countdown to History Campaign Committee (regional vice chair, 2023-27). He also served on The Rotary Foundation's Executive Committee (2019-22, chair 2020-21) and Programs Committee (2019-22, chair 2020-22). Yun received The Rotary Foundation's Distinguished Service Award in 2021-22. He was appointed an Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire by Queen Elizabeth II, awarded the Friendship Medal by the president of Mongolia, and recognized for distinguished services by the president and prime minister of Korea. He is a veteran of the Republic of Korea Army and an emeritus elder at Andong Presbyterian Church. Yun and his spouse, Eunsun, are Rotary Foundation Benefactors, Major Donors, and members of the Arch Klumph Society, the Paul Harris Society, and the Bequest Society. They have two children. Project HUMF at Anandgram Village

Under the Project HUMF, Rotary club of Amreli Gir distributed 43 Healthy nutrition kits to pregnant women and lactating mothers at Anandgram Village Devaliaya Anganwadi. One Kit included - 500 gm. Dates ,1 Kg. jaggery, 500 gm Dalia, 500 gm Penuts, 500 gm Chana, Biscuits and Bananas. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all donors for generously sponsoring todays nutrition kits.



Hearing Aid Screening Camp

RC Amreli Gir conducted a Hearing Aid Screening Camp at Dikra nu Ghar, an Old age home, where over 93 beneficiaries were screened & 32 of them were found in need for Hearing Aid Machines. This machines will be provided by the club at nominal cost.

Our Ongoing Projects



Audiology & Speech Therapy Center

Club is running an Audiology & Speech Therapy at Deaf & Dumb School. This center is done under the Global Grant of Rotary Foundation & was supported by Rotary Club of Emory Durid Hills (Dist. 6900, USA) & RI Dist. 3060. The aim of this center is to provide diagnosis & treatment related to Deaf & Dumb community of nearby areas.



Bal Vatsalya Kendra

Our club has started a Bal Vatsalya Kendra in Amreli. Basically its a child development & educational training center for rural & slum area children.. We arraigned a care taker for this childrens and started this center on 22nd of Feb 2021. We are glad to see that on the very 1st day of this center, nearly 35 childrens were present and this figure is now increasing day by day. As of now there are 109 childrens coming to this center. Care taker trains these childrens on how to Brush teeth, taking Bath, Combing their Hair & Dressing, etc. This center is open daily from 8:30 to 11:30 in morning and a healthy meal is giving to all children which attract them for coming here. Our aim is to educate maximum children of slum areas. Recurring cost of around Rs.20000-25000/- is barred by club members and SBI-RSETI. By this project club is gaining public image in the lower class of the society.



Oxygen Bank

Club had started Oxygen Bank during the 2nd wave of Covid-19 for the needy patients at refundable deposit basis. Club has total of 66 jumbo oxygen cylinders & 4 Oxygen Concentrator Machines. This was all gathered with help of local donors, who were impressed by our clubs activities and public image. As of now there are many patients in the city who requires an oxygen cylinder of their regular treatment. This project is now gaining faith & trustworthiness of the club and building a good public image in the society.

Our Ongoing Projects



Project Aadhar - Medical Equipment

Project Aadhar is a project in which our club provides Medical Equipment's to patients on a refundable deposit basis. This project was started on the Charter Installation of Club as a thought to serve the society from the very 1st day of the club. On an initial stage we filtered Medical Equipment's like Air Bed, Water Bed, Toilet Chair, Walking Stand & Sticks, Medical Beds, ect. and approached many local donors to donate for this cause. The total amount of these equipment's was around 1.50 Lakhs INR. Fortunately in a very short period of time our Donors agreed to give a handsome amount for this project. Club members fulfilled the remaining part of the amount and the project we started. This project is now having a vast effect on society and benefiting more than 15,000 beneficiaries till date thus helping the club build a better Public Image in the society.



Miyawaki Forest

Club has developed 2 Miyawaki Forests of 100 Sq. Mtr. each at Deaf & Dumb School Amreli. This method used for tree plantation is in self a innovative way and by this method we can plant more trees in a small area compared to our traditional planting method. While in this Miyawaki Forest method approx 350 trees can be planted in 100 Sq. Mt. area besides approx 80-100 trees by traditional method thus helping Rotarys new area of focus Environment. Among this, the plantation will be self sustainable after a period of 12 to 18 months where its takes a lot of efforts, precious care and time consuming in other methods. In this method we can select trees and plants depending on surrounding environment thus helping in creating a better place to live for birds.



Rotary Library at Anandgram Village Devaliya

Rotary Amreli Gir is running a Rotary Library at Anandgram Village Devaliya. This library is open for all at no cost for the students, children as well adults of the entire village who wish to expand their knowledge. This library contains more than 350 books. This project has helped the club in growing the public image of the Rotary.
