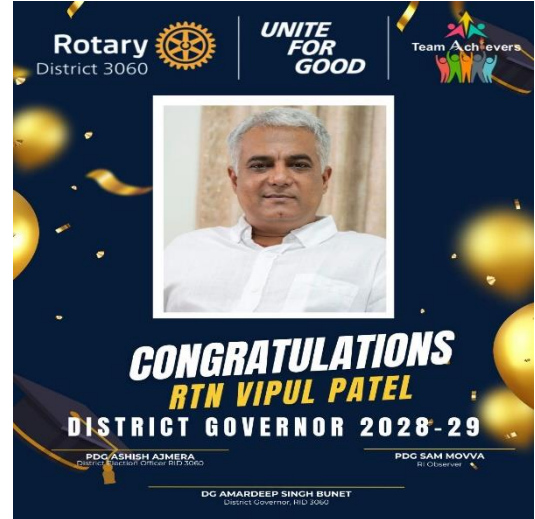

## A Visionary Chosen to Lead, A Legacy in the Making

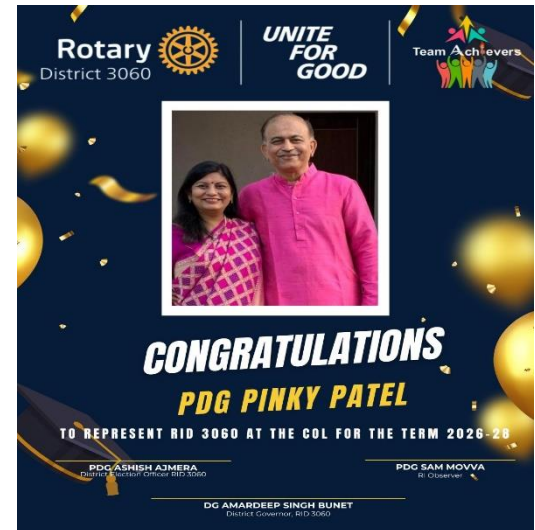

## Permanent Project Update – Mini Miyawaki Forest

**O**ur Club successfully implemented the Mini Miyawaki Plantation Project at Shekhpur in August 2025 as a long-term environmental sustainability initiative. The project was designed to create a dense, biodiverse, and self-sustaining green space using the scientifically proven Miyawaki method.



### Plantation Details

Under this project, a carefully curated mix of plant species was planted to promote ecological balance and rapid growth, including:

- Fruit-bearing trees
- Fruit-yielding plants for birds
- Medicinal plants
- High oxygen-emitting plant species
- Various flowering plants
- **Mahogany trees**, capable of growing up to **100 feet**

This diversity ensures environmental resilience, enhanced oxygen levels, and support for local biodiversity.

### Current Status & Progress

The plantation has shown excellent results within a short duration:

- **Survival Rate:** More than **95%**
- **Growth Achievement:** Several plants have already reached a height of **over 6 feet**
- **Overall Health:** Plants are healthy, dense, and growing uniformly

These outcomes clearly indicate the effectiveness of the Miyawaki method and the quality of ongoing maintenance.

### Maintenance & Sustainability Plan

The Rotary Club is committed to the regular monitoring, watering, and maintenance of the plantation. With continued care, the project is expected to evolve into a lush Mini Miyawaki Forest within the next 2–3 years, requiring minimal intervention thereafter.

The Rotary Club places on record its **special appreciation for Rtn. Umang Shah, Club Secretary**, for his exceptional dedication and utmost care in maintaining this project. His continuous supervision and hands-on involvement have been instrumental in achieving the excellent results seen today.

## Vision & Impact of this Project

### **Vision:**

To develop a self-sustaining Mini Miyawaki Forest that serves as a green lung for the region, promotes biodiversity, and inspires the community toward environmental responsibility.

### **Impact:**

- Improved air quality through high oxygen-emitting plants
- Enhanced biodiversity by supporting birds and pollinators
- Long-term environmental benefits for future generations
- A living example of Rotary's commitment to sustainable development and climate action

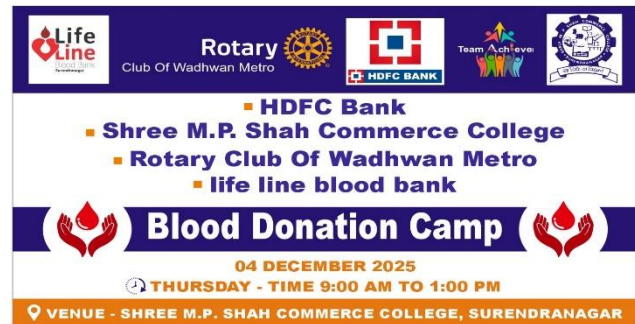
- Nutritious and hygienically prepared food

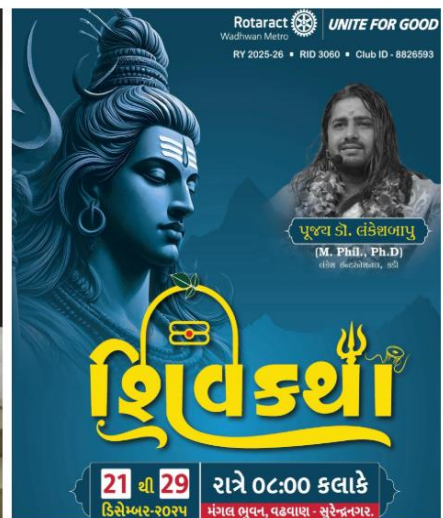

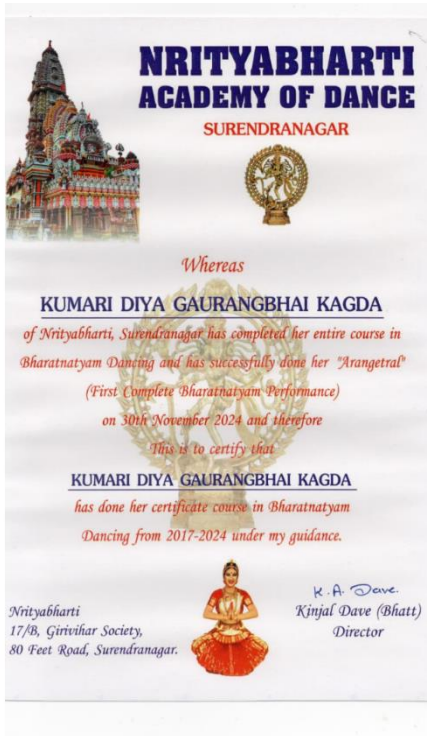


This recognition validated the project's potential to create meaningful change through awareness and innovation.
