MILESTONE PROJECTS OF ROTARY



Project Annapurna- RC Wadhwan Metro

The Rotary Project "Annapurna" is a humanitarian initiative focused on food security, community nourishment, and empowerment. It has been implemented by RC Wadhwan Metro since 2020-21. Annapurna (Annadan) Project is done every Sunday, wherein 250-300 beneficiaries from poor backgrounds are given meals along with buttermilk. Club also gives sweet on the occasion of festivals.

Idea of Annapurna came back in the year 2020-21. Food and Clean water are still not reaching to all people of the community. We started with an idea to identify a group of people with poor economical background.

There is one market which gathers every Sunday at a particular place and called as "Gujari Market". Many poor people come to this market to buy their basic necessities.

We decided to give them one-time free meal every Sunday whenever this market is gathered. This way the idea came and incorporation of the same started immediately.

We have been doing this activity since last 236 Sundays (till november 30, 2025) continuously without any break irrespective of Festival Season, Rains etc.

Source of Funding for this project is from the members of the club and their references. Members generally sponsor 1 or more Sundays based on anniversary/birthday/ death date of family members etc. Club is not dependent on any fund raising or third-party sponsorship for this project. Number of Beneficiaries annually are approximately 13,000 -15000 people.

Number of Beneficiaries till date are more than 60,000.

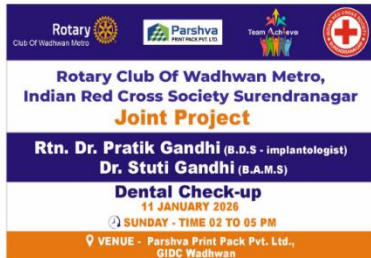
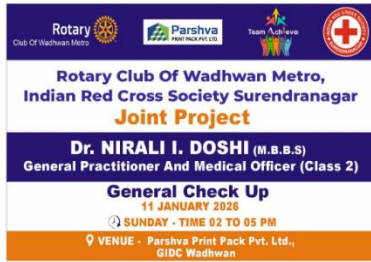

Preventive Care in Action: A Comprehensive Medical Camp

A General Medical Health Check-up Camp was successfully organized on 11th January, 2025 at the factory premises of M/s. Parshva Print Pack Pvt. Ltd. - Wadhwan City of our fellow Rtn. Niraj Shah. The camp was jointly organized by Rotary Club of Wadhwan Metro, Indian Red Cross Society – Surendranagar, and Shreemad Rajchandra Sarvamangal Hospital – Surendranagar, with the objective of promoting preventive healthcare and early diagnosis among employees and the local community.



The camp offered a wide range of medical services through experienced doctors and medical teams to 235 factory workers.
