




## TALK ON THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA



## ROTARY DIVYANG CENTRE CAMP

### FREE JAIPUR FOOT CAMP-RESTORING MOBILITY, CHANGING LIVES



The Rotary Club of New Kalyan (RCNK) and Rotary Club of NaMastu Navi Mumbai (RC NaMastu), in collaboration with PKC Hospital, Vashi, and Z-Aksys Solutions Pvt Ltd (ZSPL), successfully organised a Free Jaipur Foot Camp in two phases.

**Phase 1: Measurement Camp** (January 11, 2025)

Held at PKC Hospital, Vashi, this session ensured 25 beneficiaries were accurately measured for customised Jaipur Foot prosthetics, laying the groundwork for a precise and comfortable fit.

**Phase 2: Fitment Camp** (January 26, 2025)

The fitment camp was inaugurated by DG Rtn. Dinesh Mehta (Rotary District 3142) and attended by Dr. P. V. Battalwar (Medical Director, PKC Hospital) and other dignitaries. The event successfully provided 25 beneficiaries with free Jaipur Foot prosthetics, empowering them with renewed mobility.


