A meaningful project was carried out at the Kolkata Police Hospital as part of Rotary's Youth Service initiative. By providing a dependable and safe source of purified water within the school premises, the initiative aims to

safeguard the students' health, reduce waterborne illnesses, and create a more conducive learning environment. The installation not only fulfills an essential daily need but also empowers the school to maintain better hygiene standards, ensuring that every child has the basic right to clean and healthy drinking water.

designed Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) program, we identify and nurture their leadership potential, inspire personal growth, and bring forth their hidden talents. The initiative aims to build confidence, enhance communication skills, and create opportunities for these young individuals to realize their aspirations, thereby contributing to their overall development and strengthening community ties. Our Club was Co-Host of the event which took place from 6th November to 8th November 2025.

DONATION OF FOOD GRAIN FOR GIRL CHILDREN







Project was undertaken with the objective of providing essential nutritional support to girl children between the age of 5-18 years belonging to economically weaker families and residing in Save the Children Home Thakurpukur, a protective home environment, on 26th November 2025. Recognising that proper nutrition is the foundation for healthy growth, learning, and overall well-being, the Club organised a food-donation initiative to support these young girls who often face multiple socio-economic challenges. As part of the project, a variety of nutritious food items were donated, including staples and items that directly contribute to balanced growth.

Drive on HIV/AIDS Prevention and Rights









An AIDS Awareness Camp was organized on 2nd December 2025, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., in front of the Calcutta Mint, along the footpath area. To spread vital information, public miking was conducted, highlighting the relevant laws of the country pertaining to the rights and protection of people living with HIV/AIDS. Announcements were also made to encourage the general public to become more aware and responsible in preventing the spread of AIDS. As part of the outreach activity, informative leaflets and condoms were distributed to pedestrians as well as commuters travelling in public transport, ensuring that the message reached a large and diverse audience. The entire event was jointly organized by EKTA 24 Parganas, an organization of transgender individuals, and the Rotary Club of Calcutta Universe, reflecting a strong collaborative effort towards public health, awareness, and inclusivity.

Medical Support For Mental Patients







Rotary Club of Calcutta Universe extended a compassionate hand to the mental patients residing at SEVAC Mental Hospital, located at Samali in South 24 Parganas. The institution currently shelters around 78 male and female patients, many of whom have been abandoned by their families and left without emotional or financial support. These vulnerable individuals depend entirely on the care provided by the hospital for their treatment, medicines, and daily needs. Understanding the critical need for uninterrupted access to proper





medication—an essential component of mental health care—our Club came forward to support the institution in a meaningful way. After interacting with the authorities and assessing the immediate requirements, Rotary Club of Calcutta Universe committed to providing financial assistance toward the medicines needed for the inmates on 2nd December 2025. This contribution aims to ensure that

patients continue receiving their prescribed treatment without disruption, promoting stability, dignity, and improved quality of life.

Van Rickshaw Support for Farmers











Two van rickshaws were donated to the farmers of South 24 Parganas on 6th December 2025 with the objective of strengthening their means of livelihood. These van rickshaws will play a vital role in helping the farmers transport their harvested crops, vegetables, and other produce from the agricultural fields to nearby markets without dependency on costly external transport. By providing reliable and convenient transportation, this initiative ensures that the farmers can carry larger quantities of produce in a single trip, reduce postharvest losses, save transportation expenses, and increase their daily earnings. It also empowers them with greater mobility, independence, and flexibility in planning their market visits. Overall, the donation of the van rickshaws is a sustainable step toward supporting rural farmers, improving their income-generating opportunities, and enhancing their economic resilience in the long run.

Wheelchair Donation for a Neurologically Challenged Beneficiary





A wheelchair was donated on 9th December 2025 to a male beneficiary who is unable to stand or move independently due to a severe neurological condition. Understanding the critical need for mobility support in such cases, our club took the initiative to provide him with a sturdy and comfortable wheelchair to enhance his daily life. The donation aims to restore dignity, improve accessibility, and enable him to carry out essential activities with greater ease. This support will significantly reduce his dependency on others for movement within the home and immediate surroundings. It will also help caregivers manage his needs more effectively while improving his overall well-being. The project reflects our club's commitment to serving individuals with critical health and mobility challenges, ensuring that no one is left behind due to physical limitations.

Spreading Joy through Inclusion





As part of a Service Project, the Rotary Club of Calcutta Universe visited Mom's Care, a home for specially-abled individuals living with cerebral palsy on 12th November 2025. Club members spent quality time with the residents, engaging in personal interactions, listening to their talents, and appreciating their abilities. The initiative focused on emotional support, encouragement, and inclusion rather than material aid. The interaction brought visible joy and confidence among the inmates, making them feel valued and important members of society, while also sensitizing Rotarians towards the needs and potential of persons with disabilities.

Empowering Hands: Sewing Machines for Self Help Group









The Rotary Club donated **two sewing machines** to a local **Self Help Group (SHG)** engaged in stitching clothes free of cost for **abandoned specially-abled individuals and inmates of old age homes** on 12th December 2025. The SHG also earns a livelihood by stitching garments for residents of the surrounding area, making the initiative both **service-oriented and income-generating.**
