teachers who shape our future generations.




Ongoing projects on progress on literacy, healthcare and community initiatives that continue to bring smile and hopes.

The five awardees for the NBA 2025 are:

Samaria Pathaw is an educator with 15 years of nurturing young minds and shaping future citizens. She founded Merry Land School at Mawlein Mawkhan, Ri Bhoi District in 2010.

Batskhem Thabah has worked as an Assistant Teacher in a private school since 2017 and very recently, Batskhem started the Raibah Living Library which includes a community library, a herbarium, bee keeping sessions, story telling sessions, art and handicraft, traditional games and nature walks. He has transformed this area and have given communities agencies and a place to learn beyond the four walls of a classroom.

Thaibi Roy Choudhury is an Assistant Teacher at Laitumkhrah Bengali Higher Secondary School. Thaibi brings with her a host of skills from being a dance and yoga instructor, to theatre artist, a trained guide and an excellent skill in creative writing, script writing and rendering.

Majella Badwar is not only a teacher but a living narrative of educational revival in Meghalaya. She started her teaching career in 1995 in the then Shishu Vidyalaya (set up in 1955) which was later renamed as Clear Springs Secondary School in 2018 after much changes and transformation to the school brought about by Majella's vision and strong determination to see every included in the school system. She has won many accolades both in the state and at the national level.

Sosthiness Warshong is a Special Educator cum Orientation and Mobility Instructor at Jyoti Sroat Inclusive School, Shillong. She has a Masters in Education and a BEd in Special Education (Visual Impairment).

CLUB FELLOWSHIP AND NETWORKING






