
### Rotary Club of Chennai Hallmark

# **Rotary at COP 28**

Rotary experts are actively participating in the 28th United Nations Climate Conference (COP28) in Dubai, addressing the intersection of a changing climate with health, poverty, and other factors.

Rotary International President R. Gordon R. McInally emphasizes the mental health effects of climate-linked disasters, citing record global temperatures and their impact on mental distress and violence.

Rotary sponsors 12 youth volunteers to amplify young voices in climate discussions.

Sessions cover diverse topics, including biodiversity loss, community-led watershed protection, and the role of artificial intelligence in energy, agriculture, and disaster resilience.

Rotary's commitment extends to environmental projects, such as planting 50,000 mangrove trees in the UAE to protect coastlines and marine life.

With a delegation including Trustee Chair Barry Rassin, Rotary fosters partnerships and initiatives to address climate challenges globally.

The Rotary Foundation has allocated over US\$23.7 million for environmental projects led by Rotary members worldwide.



RC Chennai Hallmark decided to help the worst affected people of Cyclone Michaung in the nearby area. Our Club coordinated with the district authorities in RI Dist 3232, to get the relief materials sent by RC Dindigul.

comprehensive survey was conducted by President Rtn Sravanakanya, Club Advisor Rtn Rhama, Club Secretary Rtn Meenakshi and Club Trainer Rtn Sarangapani around Indira Nagar, Nanganallur, areas around **Dharmalingeswarar** Temple Nanganallur and Madipakkam area and identified around families.

The relief bags, distributed by the club included essential items such as 10 Kg of Rice, Sambar Powder, Turmeric Powder, Semia packet, Sugar, Crystal Salt, Thoor Dal, Tamarind, 200 ml Gingely Oil, 2 pads of sanitary napkin, one single bed sheet and one plastic sleeping mat.

On 13th December 2023 each family was given two kit bags along with one single bed sheet and one plastic sleeping mat. The bed sheets were sponsored by Rtn Sarangapani and the plastic bed sheets by Rtn Rhama.

Rtn Sravanakanya, Rtn Rhama, Rtn Meenakshi, Rtn Premavathi, Rtn Rajmekala, Rtn Bharathi, Rtn Vaijayantimala and Rtn Sarangapani participated in the project and distributed the relief materials. In the evening we visited Gramium Oil factory around 6 pm. Rtn Ravi Padmanabhan explained the process of oil extraction using wooden Sekku and how much they are careful in selecting the ingredients. We observed the oil production live. They produce naturally extracted cold-pressed oil i.e., Marachekku Gingelly Oil, Groundnut oil, Coconut oil. Homemade ghee. The Gramiyum in Pondicherry is known to satisfactorily cater to the demands of its customer base. The business strives to make for a positive experience through its offerings.

Their restaurant uses products of the factory with an aim to provide good food all. They have retail shops in Chennai and also export their items to other countries. Special thanks to Rtn Ravi and his brother for arranging the visit. Both
