

पंजाब के मुख्यमंत्री भगवंत सिंह मान, फरीदकोट में स्वतंत्रता दिवस पर तेगबीर सिंह को राज्य पुरस्कार से सम्मानित करते हुए और पुरस्कार ग्रहण करने के बाद तेगबीर अपने माता-पिता के साथ।

रूपनगर निवासी तेगबीर सिंह ने पर्वतारोहण के क्षेत्र में अपनी

रूपनगर, 16 अगस्त (विजय): उपलब्धियों से पंजाब और देश का नाम रोशन किया है। फरीदकोट में राज्य स्तरीय स्वतंत्रता दिवस समारोह में उन्हें उनकी उपलब्धियों के लिए मुख्यमंत्री भगवंत सिंह मान से राज्य पुरस्कार मिला।

उल्लेखनीय है कि तेगबीर सिंह यरोप की सबसे ऊंची पर्वत चोटी, माऊंट एल्ब्रस, जो 18,510 फीट ऊंची हैं, पर चढ़ने वाले दुनिया के सबसे कम उम्र के व्यक्ति हैं।

तेगबीर को उनकी असाधारण उपलब्धि के लिए अकाल तख्त के जत्थेदार द्वारा सिरोपा ( सम्मान का चोला) और श्री साहिबं (तलवार) से भी सम्मानित किया गया।

#### पक्षियों को पिंजरे में बंद करने की बजाय उन्हें आजाद उड़ने दें : राजकुमार कपूर



रूपनगर, 18 अगस्तः तेजी से हो रहे शहरीकरण के कारण पश्चियों की आबादी लगातार घट रही है और लोग प्रकृति से दूर हो रहे हैं। कुछ लोगों को आसमान में उड़ने वाले पश्चियों के पिंजरें में बंद रखने का शौक भी होता है और कई बार उनके पंख भी काट दिए जाते हैं। इस संबंधी ओल्ड स्टडैंट एसो. के अध्यक्ष राजकमार कपर ने बताया कि जितनी तेजी से शहरीकरण बढ़ रहा है ठीक उतनी ही तेजी से हम लोग प्रकृति से दूर हो रहे है। जिसका सीधा असर पर्यावरण पर देखने को मिल रहा है। उन्होंने कहा कि जंगली पश्चियों को कई कारणों से पालतू जानवरों के रूप में खरीदा जाता है। उन्होंने कहा कि लगभग 75 प्रतिशत पक्षी बिक्री के बिंदू से पहले ही मर जाते हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि छोटे पिंजरे पक्षियों की आयु पर भी विपरीत

प्रभाव डालते हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि मालिकों को भी इस बात का जान होना चाहिए कि अच्छा पोषण कैसे प्रदान किया जाए और पश्चियों को रोगग्रस्त होने के जोखिम को कैसे कम किया जाए और जब तक यह बदलाव नहीं किए जाते पश्चियों को पालतु जानवर के रूप में रखने की अनुमति नहीं दी जानी चाहिए। तापमान में उतार चढ़ाव के कारण प्रवासी पक्षी अपने मन पसंद क्षेत्रों में शीघ्र पहुंच जाते हैं। ऐसे स्थानों को उनके अनुकूल बनाए जाने की बहुत जरूरत है। जलवायु परिवर्तन ने प्रवासी पक्षियों के जीवन में भी अनिश्चितता ला दी है। जिससे उनका अस्तित्व खतरे में पड गया है। उन्होंने कहा कि छात्रों को प्रकृति पार्कों में ले जाना और उन्हें प्रकृति आवासों में पक्षियों और जानवरों को देखने की मूल बातें सिखाना एक आनंद दायक और शिक्षाप्रद अनुभव हो सकता है।


