I am deeply grateful for the opportunity to lead our Rotary mission, HUM (Humanity Unites Mankind) and I thank each one of you for your trust and encouragement.



REGULAR CLUB MEETING



ROTARY CO-PILOT PROJECT

An Initiative by Rtn. Shalini Prakash, Partner to District Governor 2025–26, RI District 3080

The **Rotary Co-Pilot Project** is a unique initiative designed to meaningfully engage Rotary Partners (spouses of Rotarians) as active contributors to Rotary's mission of service. Recognizing their invaluable support and potential, this initiative empowers them to independently conceptualize and execute community service projects under their own leadership — creating a strong sense of purpose, belonging, and ownership.

Just as co-pilots play a vital role in navigating any journey, our Rotary Partners — now respectfully titled Rotary Co-Pilots — are envisioned as equal companions in the journey of Rotary service alongside their Rotarian spouses. This project acknowledges their contribution and provides a structured platform to lead impactful initiatives with confidence and autonomy.

Objectives:

- To provide Rotary Partners with independent leadership roles in community service projects.
- To strengthen the bond between Rotary and its extended family through inclusive participation.
- To recognize and celebrate the contributions of Rotary Partners at the district level.

Proposed Projects Under the Co-Pilot Banner:

1. Eco Bags / Eco Bricks:

Promote the segregation of plastic waste at the source to encourage recycling, protect the environment, and enhance cleanliness in surrounding areas.

2. Save Water:

Launch initiatives that spread awareness about water conservation and offer practical, sustainable solutions.

3. Save Environment:

Undertake environment-friendly activities such as plantation drives, discourage use of plastic in household, or local clean-up campaigns.

4. Senior Citizen Recreation Centre:

Establish or support community spaces focused on the well-being, engagement, and dignity of senior citizens.

5. Recipe Booklet:

Curate and publish a collection of traditional and innovative recipes shared by Rotary Partners to foster creativity, culture, and camaraderie.

Flexibility & Freedom to Innovate:

Rotary Co-Pilots are encouraged to take up any service project they are passionate about. The only guideline is that the project must be conceived, led, and executed entirely by Rotary Partners, without direct involvement from their Rotarian spouses — particularly male members.

This initiative is not just about service — it is about recognition, identity, and empowerment. It ensures that every partner feels seen, valued, and integral to Rotary's mission of creating lasting change.

Let us celebrate the strength of partnership — in life, and in service.


