








## Speaker in the Meeting



Dr. B.P.S. Parmar Delivers Inspiring Lecture on The Rotary Foundation

Dr. B.P.S. Parmar, Director of International Services, led an insightful session on **The Rotary Foundation**, enlightening members about its mission, impact, and avenues for involvement.

#### **Key Highlights of the Session:**

#### 1. Types of Contributions

Dr. Parmar explained how contributions fuel the Foundation's global initiatives, including:

- Annual Fund: Supports Rotary's humanitarian projects and grants.
- PolioPlus Fund: Dedicated to eradicating polio worldwide.
- **Endowment Fund:** Ensures long-term sustainability through perpetual grants.
- **Disaster Response Fund:** Provides immediate aid during crises.
- District & Global Grants: Funds local and international service projects.
- Corporate & Matching Gifts: Enhances donations through employer partnerships.

#### 2. Recognitions & Honors

He highlighted prestigious recognitions for donors, such as:

- Paul Harris Fellow (PHF): Awarded for a \$1,000 contribution.
- Multiple PHF Recognition: For additional \$1,000 increments.
- Major Donor: Granted to those who contribute \$10,000 or more.
- **Arch Klumph Society:** Honors cumulative donations of \$250,000+.
- **Bequest Society:** Recognizes planned giving through wills/estates.
- Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service: For exceptional volunteer contributions.

Dr. Parmar emphasized how these contributions and recognitions strengthen Rotary's ability to drive change, from polio eradication to clean water and education projects.

## ROTARY AND ME

Tan, Man, Dhan se Sewa – The Spirit of Rotary

"सेवा परमो धर्मः"—Service Above Self is not just the Rotary motto; it is a timeless ideal embedded in

Indian philosophy and values. When we say "तन, मन, धन से सेवा", we evoke a powerful trinity—physical service, heartfelt dedication, and financial commitment. These three elements, when combined, form the very backbone of meaningful and sustainable service. For every true

 $Rotarian, this \, phrase \, is \, not \, just \, poetic \\ --it \, is \, deeply \, practical, profoundly \, personal, \, and \, spiritually \, satisfying.$ 

As an **Income Tax Consultant by profession**, I have experienced how service can be rendered not only through Rotary projects, but also through one's daily work. When I guide an elderly taxpayer through complex procedures, help a small trader navigate notices, or assist a family facing financial scrutiny—and sometimes do it **without charging a fee**, especially when I know they are struggling—I feel I'm living the true spirit of Rotary.

That, to me, is "Sewa"—profession blended with compassion, knowledge offered with humility, and expertise used for the good of others.

#### Tan (Body) ਰੋਜ-Serving with Presence and Action

Rotary is a hands-on organization. Whether it's building schools, organizing blood donation camps, or participating in tree plantation drives, Rotarians are present **on the ground**. They roll up their sleeves and engage physically in the act of service. Similarly, in our professional lives too, being **physically available**—not just during office hours but even during someone's time of stress—is service through Tan. For me, accompanying a senior citizen to the tax office, or spending hours helping a family through a scrutiny case, is part of my physical presence in service.

#### Man (Mind and Heart) मन-Serving with Empathy and Passion

The "Man" in service is about **sensitivity and understanding**. In Rotary, we serve with heart—be it mentoring youth or comforting the distressed.

In my consulting practice, I have seen that **listening patiently** to someone's financial worries, understanding the fear behind a notice, or simply guiding someone in their language and comfort zone—can mean a lot. Giving people the confidence that they are not alone is a form of service with Man—mind guided by empathy.

#### Dhan (Wealth) 역 - Serving with Generosity and Stewardship

In Rotary, we give generously to causes that uplift lives. Many of us contribute to **The Rotary Foundation**, sponsor community projects, or donate to scholarships.

Professionally too, we sometimes contribute our "Dhan" in the form of free or subsidized services. Many of my clients, especially those from weaker sections, have never been charged a rupee. And that too is a form of financial giving—not as charity, but as responsibility.

#### Unite for Good – The Rotary Way

When Tan, Man, and Dhan come together, we truly "Unite for Good." This year's Rotary International Theme beautifully reflects what happens when actions, intentions, and resources align in harmony. It is not just in large service projects but also in our daily acts of integrity and kindness, in our professions, and in our personal lives that we live the ideal of Rotary. Let us pledge to make our professional expertise an extension of our Rotary spirit, and our Rotary identity a reflection of our daily conduct.






## **REGULAR CLUB MEETING**








## FROM THE EDITOR DESK
