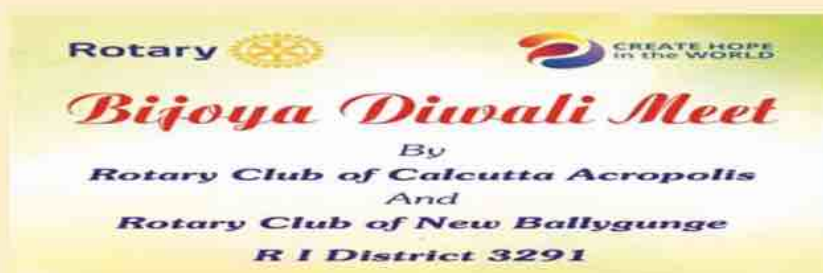

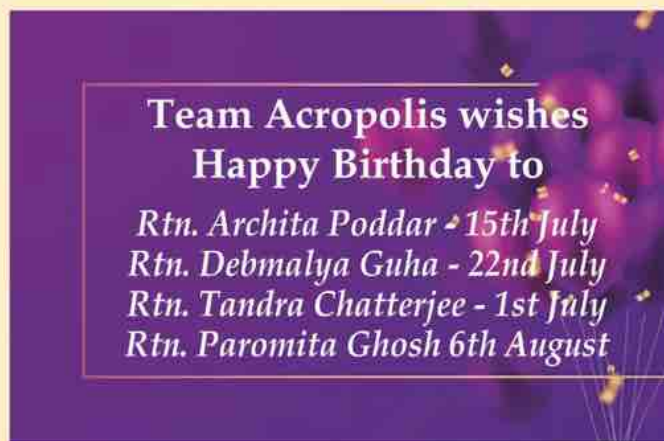
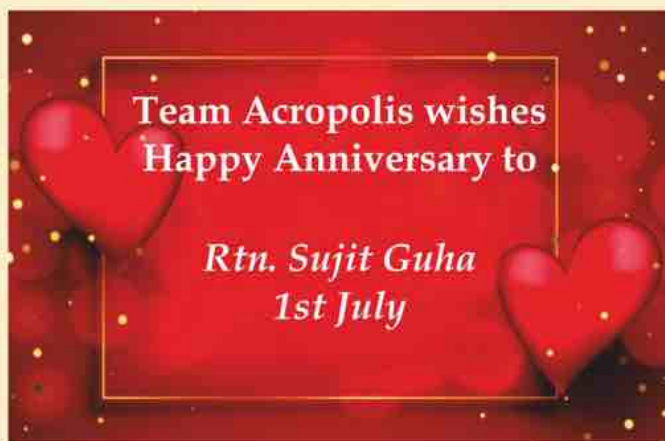
BIO TOILET
