ROTARY KASARAGOD'S LANDMARK GLOBAL GRANT PROJECT 'ROTARY KASARAGOD MOBILE BLOOD COLLECTION VAN'

On May 13th, 2025, the Rotary Club of Kasaragod achieved a historic milestone by officially donating the 'Rotary Kasaragod Mobile Blood Collection Van'-a fully equipped vehicle worth ₹ 35 lakhs-to the Government General Hospital, Kasaragod. This marks the club's first-ever Global Grant Project, benefitting not just the hospital but also private healthcare providers and the broader community across the district.

This achievement is a testament to the leadership of President Rtn. MD. Dr. Narayana Naik, who initiated the project with a generous personal contribution of ₹ 10 lakhs to The Rotary Foundation.
