



The Rotary Club of Pilathara was established in 2008, with Club No. 78753, as part of Rotary International District 3202. **Chartered on 9th April 2008**, the club began its journey with 20 dedicated charter members under the dynamic leadership of Charter President Rtn. Er. K. Raveendran, a visionary engineering educationist and a socially committed philanthropist. The club was sponsored by the Rotary Club of Payyanur and was formally inaugurated on 9th June 2008 in a grand ceremony by the then District Governor, Rtn. L. Narayanaswamy. The formation and initial development of the club were expertly guided by the Governor's Special Representative, Rtn. MD Dr. Santhosh Sreedhar, a true mentor to the club, and Rtn. C.T. Narayanan, then President of the Rotary Club of Payyanur.

After completing the initial formalities, the club commenced its full-fledged operations on 1st July 2008, marking the beginning of a new Rotary year. Under the capable leadership of Charter President Rtn. Er. Prof. K. Raveendran and Secretary Rtn. Prof. P.V. George, the club took its first significant steps toward making a lasting impact in the community. Rtn. M. Prakash served as the District Governor during this period. The club's leadership team included Treasurer Rtn. K. Damodaran and five Directors responsible for the key avenues of service - Club Administration, Community Service, Vocational Service, International Service, and New Generation Service.

From the outset, the Rotary Club of Pilathara was deeply committed to Rotary's values and ethics. The club members actively engaged in Rotary awareness programs, ensuring that the importance of weekly meetings and structured service projects was well understood. The guidance and unwavering support from the sponsor club, Rotary Club of Payyanur, played a crucial role in stabilizing and nurturing the new club during its formative years.

In its inaugural year, the club successfully completed approximately 33 service projects across various avenues of service, earning recognition within Rotary District 3202. Notable initiatives included eye check up / cataract operation camp, Dental camp for school students at Pilathara UP School, Ayurveda Camp for the public, Polio immunization program at PHC Pilathara, Vocational Excellence Award presentation, Distribution of Water filters and Purifiers and the distribution of Onam kits and Onakkodi to the differently-abled residents of Asraya Swasraya Sangam, Mathamangalam. These impactful programs quickly established the club as a pillar of service in the local communities of Pilathara and neighboring panchayaths, including Cheruthazham, Kadannappalli, Perul, and Kunhimangalam.

The outstanding efforts of the club in its first year did not go unnoticed. The Rotary Club of Pilathara received three prestigious awards, recognizing its excellence in public image initiatives and its dedicated participation in the Pulse Polio Immunization Program. These early achievements set a strong foundation for the club's future endeavors, reinforcing its commitment to the Rotary motto: **Service Above Self.**



Despite these logistical challenges, the club continued to thrive, steadily building its reputation as a committed and dynamic force for community service.



During its second year (2009-10), the club was led by Rtn. Late PHF MV Purushothaman, an esteemed educationalist, alongside Secretary Rtn. Prof. PV George. Under Rtn. Purushothaman's leadership, the club reached new heights through impactful humanitarian service programs. Major projects from this period included a Mega Medical Camp in collaboration with Minerva Hospital, Mangalore, for the early detection of heart diseases, as well as Ayurveda and eye check-up camps. The club also extended financial assistance to Sree Narayana School, Payyanur, launched a tailoring and garment-making course for young girls, and provided financial aid to cancer patients. A particularly notable initiative was the annual Onam kit and clothing distribution to the visually impaired residents of Asraya Swasraya Sangam, a program personally sponsored by Rtn. MV Purushothaman that continues to this day.

The club's dedicated efforts earned special awards from District Governor Dr. Sagadevan, recognizing its balanced community service approach and outstanding mega medical camp for heart disease detection.

A significant milestone during the year was the club's recognition by the District Governor for its impactful participation in the Pulse Polio Immunization program. This recognition highlighted the club's dedication to public health initiatives and its increasing visibility in the district.

During this period, the club executed nearly 50 service projects across various areas of focus. Some of the most notable initiatives included the distribution of bicycles and computer printers to Perul UP School, conducting medical camps, organizing tailoring classes for skill development, planting trees to promote environmental protection, and installing traffic signboards for public safety. Importantly, this was the first year the club made a contribution to The Rotary Foundation (TRF), showcasing a growing awareness of Rotary's global mission. On 21st June 2011, President Rtn. KP Balan became the club's first Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) by contributing USD 1,000 to The Rotary Foundation (TRF). On the same day, Past President Rtn. MV Purushothaman also attained PHF status. However, due to a communication and processing error, the contribution made by Charter President Rtn. Er. K Raveendran was mistakenly credited to Rtn. KM Raveendran, resulting in the latter being recognized as a PHF in the system.

While the club welcomed three new members into its fold, four existing members discontinued their association, bringing the total membership at the end of the term to 24. Despite these changes, the club remained steady in its momentum and continued to grow in service, recognition, and fellowship.

Another notable development during the year was the **launch of the club's official website**, a step that strengthened its public image and digital presence. The introduction of a **bi-monthly club bulletin** further enhanced communication among members and improved Rotary visibility in the region. During the same period, **Dr. Ranjith Raveendran earned the Paul Harris Fellow (PHF)** recognition, while five enthusiastic new members were inducted into the club, strengthening its membership base.

The club undertook **around 45 impactful service projects**, aligning closely with all **district priority areas**. These projects covered a wide range of community needs and showcased the club's commitment to balanced and inclusive service. The quality and diversity of its initiatives earned the club **five distinguished awards** from the Rotary District. Among them were the **Best Change Maker Club Award** for upholding high ethical standards and the **Best Club for Enforcing a Non-Liquor Policy**, reinforcing the club's stance on healthy social values.

Additionally, the club was recognized for its efforts in women empowerment, vocational service, and world understanding and peace, cementing its reputation as a well-rounded and socially responsible Rotary club. The Rotary year 2012-13 marked a significant chapter in the journey of the Rotary Club of Pilathara. The mantle of leadership was passed on to **Rtn. Er. E Kunhiraman**, a professional electrical engineer, in a grand and memorable installation ceremony held on **23**rd **June 2012**. Under his able leadership, the club continued its evolution into a mature and dynamic unit, effectively balancing efforts in both club administration and community service.

One of the standout achievements of the year was the successful organization of a **two-day Regional RYLA**. This event was a milestone for the club as it was the **first time** that Rotary Pilathara hosted a regional-level program. It not only elevated the club's standing within the Rotary community but also showcased its organizational capability and commitment to youth development.

The club also implemented several impactful community service projects during the year. Among them, the **installation of a Bio-Gas Plant** worth ₹2 lakhs at **HOPE Charitable Trust** demonstrated a commitment to sustainable and ecofriendly initiatives. The **distribution of 100 wheelchairs** to differently-abled individuals further highlighted the club's dedication to inclusivity and social support.

Health and wellness remained a priority, with the club organizing a variety of medical camps in collaboration with Pariyaram Medical College. These included general medical, dental, and Ayurveda camps, along with active participation in the Pulse Polio Immunization campaign. Additionally, vocational training programs in tailoring and garment making were conducted, empowering local women with practical skills to support their livelihoods.

Membership also saw positive growth during this period. **Six new members** joined the club, bringing the total membership to **35**. This growth reflected the club's increasing influence and the appeal of its service-oriented mission.

During the Rotary year 2019-20, under the dynamic leadership of Rtn. PHF N.V.
