

### **MEETING No: 1770**

#### **Dated 26 July 2023**

Meeting no 1770 was held on 26 July 2023 at Hotel Sunbeam, Chandigarh. The President welcomed all the Rotarians present. All protocols of Rotary were followed. The agenda points were taken pointwise:

- Α. One minute silence was observed to pay homage to Martyrs of Kargil War on Kargil Vijay Diwas.
- B. Rtn H S Saggu was pinned with Paul Harris Fellowship recognition 4th time by AG Rtn Sanjeev Checker.
- C. Rtn Pardeep Sekhri, a new member was also pinned by AG Rtn Sanjeev Checker.
- D. Information regarding the following projects was given to members:
  - 1. Annapurna Day on 1st July 2023.
  - 2. Blood Donation Camp was organised at IMA hall in collaboration of IMA Chandigarh state on 1st July 2023.
  - 3. National Doctors' Day Celebrations was celebrated on 1st July 2023 in collaboration with IMA Chandigarh in IMA Hall Sec 35, Chandigarh.
  - Dry ration packets for flood affected people and two submersible dewatering pumps 4. were handed over to DC Mohali On 13th July 2023.
  - 20 Umbrellas distributed to Street Vendors. 5.
- E. Projects to be undertaken in near future:
  - Handing over two toilet blocks to MC Chandigarh: It was informed by President that 1. two toilet blocks which are already available with us will be handed over to MC Chandigarh and these will be installed in Dhanas where MC is constructing platforms. This is bit delayed due to unprecedented rains.
  - 2. Sanitary pads Vending machines: It was informed that the vending machines would be installed in Govt. girls' schools in collaboration with Chandigarh University. It was further informed that the board has already approved to execute this project and it was further deliberated that to start with we should meet DEO and get data regarding the Govt. Girls Schools and Co-educational Schools in Rural & Urban areas of Chandigarh where these vending machines can be provided. Then the area wise list would be shared to members to visit these schools in groups of 3-4 Rotarians and submit their feasibility report. Accordingly, we would tie up with Chandigarh University to execute this project with their collaboration.
  - 3. Distribution of Tricycles for handicapped people, Cycles for school going girls and dual benches for schools:

Tricycles	5	Rs. 4000	Rs. 20000
Cycles	20	Rs. 2000	Rs. 40000
Dual benches	40	Rs. 600	Rs. 24000







It was discussed that first the beneficiaries should be identified. President requested the Rotarians to donate for this project generously.

- 4. Prosthetic limbs camp in September 2023: It was informed by President that a camp has been planned for the month of September 2023 in association with CU. It was further informed that Board has discussed, we should finalise the prosthetic hand and legs to be fixed to beneficiaries as we have not received good feedback for legs which were fixed in earlier camps and that we should look for better alternative to the mechanical LN4 hands and electronic hand fixed earlier. deliberations it was decided that 4 Rotary members i.e., Rtn Ashish Midha, Rtn Sunil Kansal, Rtn R S Cheema and Rtn S P Ojha would visit Jaipur Foot office at Ambala to see the feasibility and durability of their products and submit report to Core Committee to decide further course of action. The Ambala office was closed due to flooding in their area for the last 15 days. Now, they have started working and the team will be visiting on 27th July. On Sunday 23-07-23 we had Zoom meeting with President of RC of New Kalyan. They are ready to hold the legs camp with us. The dates fixed with them are 17th September for measurements of legs and 08th October for fitment.





