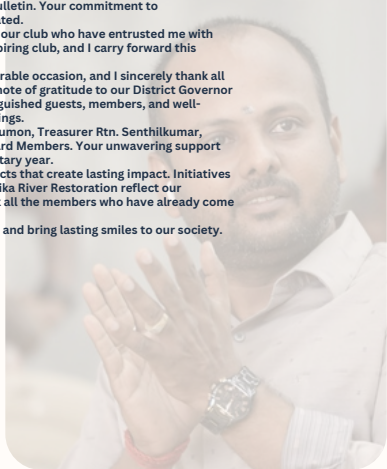
Message from District Governor
