The Concept of haiku...by PP Neena Singh ...A Poet and Rotarian

Haiku, the traditional Japanese form of poetry, distills profound moments into just three lines—typically following a 5-7-5 syllable pattern. English language syllabic tones are longer so we use lesser syllables. But more than a formula, composing haiku is a path.

Rooted in nature and the seasons, haiku invites readers to pause, reflect, and find meaning in simplicity. Though brief, each haiku offers a window into the poet's perception, often capturing contrasts—between the fleeting and the eternal, solitude and connection, or stillness and movement. Its power lies in suggestion, not explanation, evoking emotion and



insight through minimal words.

In today's fastpaced world, haiku encourages mindfulness and presence. It reminds us to notice the quiet moments of

change, to honor diversity, and to foster harmony with both nature and each other. By embracing haiku, we celebrate not only creativity but also the shared human experience that transcends borders.
