

Chandigarh 19 October 2024: -Bhavan Vidyalaya Chandigarh is delighted to continue its transatlantic partnership with Webb School, Knoxville, Tennessee, USA. As a part of the Rotary Exchange Program, established in 2012 this fall, a 12-member student's delegation accompanied by 2 teachers will embark on a 10day cultural and academic exchange program, starting October 19, 2024.

The program aims at offering a comprehensive experience, bridging cultural divides and cultivating world citizens through academic interactions, workshops, collaborative projects, group discussions, and reflective journaling at Webb School. Additionally, students will explore Knoxville's natural and historical treasures—including the Tennessee Museum, Smoky Mountains, and

Dollywood theme park—and engage with the local community through a Rotary meeting.

Bhavan Vidyalaya Chandigarh and Webb School, Knoxville, have fostered a strong bond through the Rotary Exchange Program since its inception in 2012. This partnership has facilitated multiple reciprocal visits, including Knoxville delegations to the school in 2014, 2019 (7 students, 2 chaperones), and 2022 (10 students, 3 teachers). as well as the Bhavan's delegation to Knoxville in 2019 (7 students, 1 chaperone).

Mrs. Vineeta Arora, Director Education cum Senior Principal, spoke on the occasion of the delegation's departure, saving she was delighted to continue the partnership with Webb School. She added that this partnership offered valuable opportunities for growth and reinforced their dedication to global education, cultivating global citizens and lifelong learners.

A delegation from Webb School, Knoxville is scheduled to visit Bhavan Vidyalaya Chandigarh in August 2025, further strengthening ties.
