Feb 14th Tribute To The Bravehearts Of Pulwama:

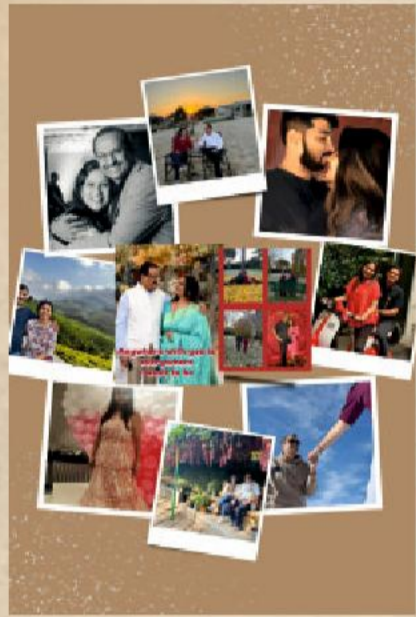
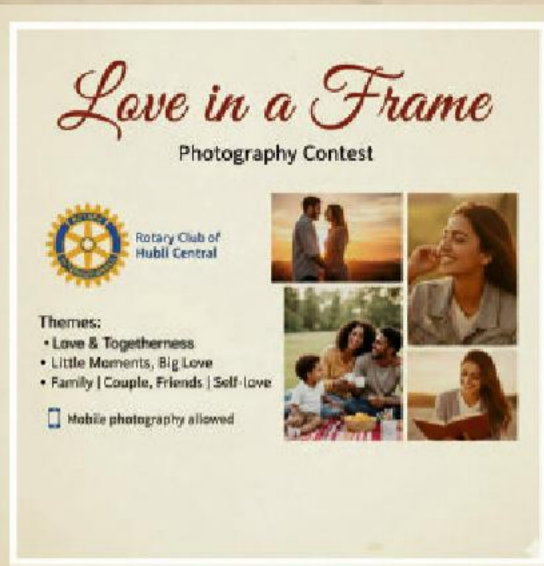


