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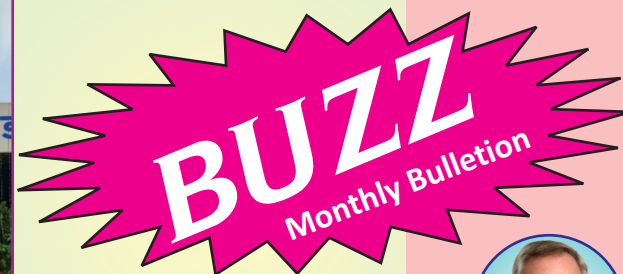

a) A family outing was jointly planned with RCH elite early in the morning to Neersagar followed by breakfast.

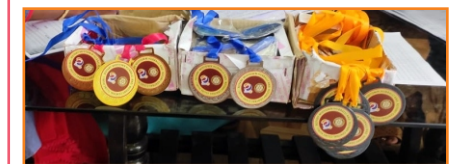
b) MHM and WASH program was conducted at Moon Maternity Hospital by Rtn. Dr. Mamta Patil to 50 people present.
