PDG RTN STUTI AGRAWAL

PDG Rtn Stuti Agrawal has the distinction of being the first lady President of one of the oldest clubs of District 3120, Rotary Allahabad in 2005-06. Again she became the first woman to become the District Governor of Rotary International District 3120 for the year 2018-19.

As the District Governor of RID 3120 for 2018-19, her personal touch coupled with excellent management took the District to great heights. She was awarded for Membership Increase and Percentage Increase.

For Rotary Foundation she reached a target till now unthinkable for RI District 3120. The District Assembly was organized in East Europe (Hungary and Czech Republic) destinations not even thought of till now.

During her tenure as DG she undertook to educate women in menstrual hygiene and installed 130 sanitary napkin vending machines in Girls educational Institutions and public places. 20 breast feeding cabins were installed at big hospitals, railway stations and other public places where the mother can breastfeed the child in peace. She continues to donate sanitary napkin vending machines

Stuti has been serving RI actively. She was ARPIC (Assistant Regional Public Image Coordinator) for RI Zone 6 for the year 2020-21 and 2021-22

1) Asst Zonal Ambassador of Empowering Girls Initiative of Zone 6

2) District Trainer of RID 3120

Stuti will be ARC Zone 6 for 2023-24

COL Representative from RID 3120 for year 2023-26

It was a great honour when she was featured on the Cover Page of Rotary National Magazine, 'Rotary News' and 'Rotary Samachar' in the issue of August in 2003 with a complete feature story inside.

Stuti is member of various Cultural and Social organizations in Prayagraj. She has been serving on the Boards of Educational Institutions

After completing her schooling she studied to be the 1st female Mechanical Engineer from MNNIT Allahabad. She worked for various Engineering Companies in India and Abroad.

At present she is Administrator of family run hospital in Prayagraj.
