### JULY

#### Atma Raksha (On going Project)



Chaired by Rtn. Smriti Shangloo, Director of Red Belt Academy, a Self Defence Camp was organised at Mahila Sewa Sadan, Baiharana on 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> of July by the academy. It empowers women to protect themselves in unexpected and threatening situations. About 252 girls are being trained.

#### Taru Vithika (On going project)



Rotary Allahabad Midtown organised a plantation drive on 19th July at Lala Manmohan Das Inter College, Jhunsi, where 100 samplings were planted and on 23th at Parade Ground under the leadership of Rtn. Anil Agarwal, Rotary District Chair Environment, along with other Rotary clubs a whopping 10,000 samplings were planted.

#### Ayushman Bhav



Organised under the able leadership of Rtn. Vidup Agrahari, the medical camp at Saraswati bal Mandir, Inter College, Naini helped us serve 501 patients. ### (Cervical Cancer awareness Campaign)



An awareness campaign was conducted by Rotary Allahabad Midtown in various phases to educate young women and their families about the importance of preventive healthcare and early detection of cervical cancer. An awareness was created on the role

of Gardasil vaccine, which has successfully helped in preventing Cervical Cancer.

1. On 28th August, in collaboration with Mahila Gram Inter College, Subedar Ganj, Rtn Dr. Vandana Bansal explained its causes, symptoms, and the critical role of early diagnosis. She highlighted that cervical cancer is largely preventable through timely vaccination and awareness. 184 students attended this program.
2. On Saturday 30th August at LDC Public School, Soraon, Dr. Amrita Chaurasiya explained its causes, symptoms, and the critical role of early diagnosis. She said that the vaccine is most effective between the ages of 9 to 14 for the girls. 158 girls had participated in this awareness campaign.

### New Generation Services



1. The Interact club of SIS under the aegis of Rotary Allahabad Midtown held a talk at Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram on Emotion management and confidence building by teachers of Sanskaar International School on Thursday 7th August. The event aimed at helping students recognize and articulate their emotions effectively, to promote healthy communication and emotional intelligence, daily hygiene practices and to help them cope with home sickness. 52 students were benefited.

#### 2. Flood Relief

She said that Vaccine, against deadly HPV Virus GARDASIL, is 100% safe and can be administered on females between 9 to 20 years of age. 550 students were present during this talk.

### Matri Shakti- Vaccination Drive



Our club organised three successful and massive cervical cancer vaccination drives.

1. Mahaprabhu Public School & Vidya Vahini on 24th September. A total of 500 HPV vaccines were administered to 500 girls aged between 12-18 years.
2. At Lala Manmohan Das Inter college & Preeti hospital on 25th September. Total of 650 girls were benefitted this time. The camp was very well organised by Rtn. PP Neeraj Mehrotra.
3. At United College of engineering & GGIC on 26th September, benefiting 350 girls who were vaccinated.

A total of 1500 girls were vaccinated in Prayagraj out of which 927 has been administered by RAM alone, which is a milestone in itself. This could not have been possible without the relentless efforts of the Coordinators Rtn. PP Pankaj Jain and Rtn. PP Sanjay Gupta.

All medical norms were followed by the medical team as well as Rotary Allahabad Midtown, Rotary Royal, Rotary Academia, Rotary Grand, Rotary Sangam, Rotary Allahabad & Rotary Elite contributed to this massive vaccination drive. The vaccines were provided free of cost. The club provided snacks to beneficiaries who got themselves vaccinated.


