PEP UP - WELL BEINGThis Global Grant funded Mental Health project with the target age group of 13-21 years old boys & girls, to be implemented byan experienced NGO called "ManoJagruti" was launched in a ceremony on 15th July 2025 at Samskruti School, a Charitable Trust School, located in Raghavendra Colony, Kondapur. Club President Rtn Suresh Babu, Project T. . Convenor Rtn P. Vanasri. Coordinator Rtn J.M. Reddy, Club Secretary Rtn Madhavi Nalluri, Project implementing





partner & Manojagruti's Director Mrs Geetha Challa, her team of counsellors and School promoter Shri M. Lakshman participated.Addressing the children of Class VIII & IX, Lakshman Underlined the relevance and the urgent need for a holistic approach. The project is aimed at providing Mental Health awareness, with daily counselling, therapy, training in 7 different academic institutions, including 3 private schools, 2 Govt Schools, 2 Junior Colleges and 1 Engineering College in the surrounding areas, with almost 2500 beneficiaries, with expected implementation by the end of the current Rotary year. RCHM members Vice President Rtn D. Lakshminarayana, Rtn V. Nageshwara Rao, Jt Secretary,Rtn Madhusudhan Rao, Dr Kameshwari, Mrs J. Vijayalakshmi and others were also present in the ceremony.





'Eye Camp' with the support of "Pushpagiri Eye Hospital"

Rotary Club of Hyderabad Mavericks has jointly with 'Ananda' Foundation conducted an 'Eye Camp' with the support of "Pushpagiri Eye Hospital", for children aged between 5 to 15 years on 25th & 26th at ZPHS in Janwada. A total of 475 children were examined, wherein spectacles were prescribed for 98 children which were donated at a



total cost of 30 K @Rs 300 each) with kind donations by some of our members and by the club. The same were distributed to these children by Rtn Seetha Anand, Rtn Suresh Babu and Rtn Nageswara Rao subsequently. A 'Speaker Meet' on Nutrition & Well being by eminent nutritionist Ms. Sridevi Jasti. She delivered very informative and insightful talk to the Xth class girls students, women teachers and Parents about healthy food habits and life style. Rtn Seetha Anand has taken the initiative in organising it.. Rtn Suresh Babu, Rtn Vanasri, Rtn Bhargavi, Rtn Madhusudan Rao, Rtn Anamika, Rtn P Narayan garu and Rtn Madhavi were present.


