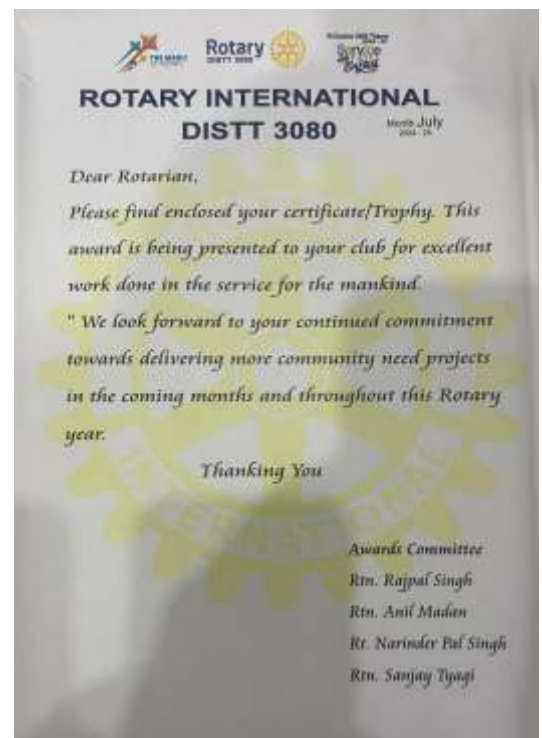

सुमन पैविलोमा वायरस (एच.पी.वी) से होने वाले इस घातक तथा कष्टप्रद सर्विकल कैंसर से महिलाओं को आजीवन सुरक्षा दी जा सकती है। उन्हें 9 से 14 साल तक की आयु के बीच, एच.पी.वी. वैक्सिन के दो टीके 6-6 मास के अन्तर पर लगवाना एकमात्र उपाय है। यह वैक्सिन यौनि, गुदा, लिंग, गले और मुँह के कैंसर को भी प्रभावी रूप से रोकती है, आयुवित होने के कारण अब तक एच.पी.वी. वैक्सिन बहुत महंगी थी। किन्तु अब अपने देश में बनने के कारण इसका मूल्य कम हो गया है। यह वह अभी भी आम अरामी की पहुँच से बाहर है। रोटी इंटरनेशनल, रोटी फाउन्डेशन, स्थानीय रोटी क्लब्स तथा जन सहयोग से ये टीके आजकल मुफ्त लगवाये जा रहे हैं।

टीकाकरण के बाद भी निजी सफाई और नियमित जांच - एच.पी.वी. टेस्ट और पैप टेस्ट अपने डॉक्टर की सलाह से करवाने रहना चाहिए। इस प्रकार इन उपायों को अपना कर आप इस भयानक बीमारी से आजीवन सुरक्षित रह सकते हैं।
