OUR PERMANENT PROJECTS

Service Projects by Rotary Club Muzaffarnagar Chamber

Rotary Club Muzaffarnagar Chamber has been actively engaged in impactful community service projects for the past 28 years, reflecting its unwavering commitment to social welfare and development. The Club has undertaken and sustained several initiatives aimed at improving the quality of life for the underprivileged and promoting education, health, and skill development. Some of its key projects include:

- **Clean Drinking Water Initiative:** Installation of **9 water coolers** at various public locations across the city, with regular maintenance to ensure continued access to safe and clean drinking water.
- **Digital Education Support:** Establishment of **3 fully equipped computer labs** in schools located in remote areas, helping bridge the digital divide and enabling students to learn basic computer skills.
- **Women Empowerment:** Operation of a **free Tailoring Training Centre** exclusively for women, aimed at empowering them with practical stitching skills and promoting self-reliance.
- **Affordable Healthcare:** Running of a **Homeopathic Clinic**, staffed by a qualified doctor paid by the Club. The clinic provides consultations for just ₹20, with **free distribution of medicines**, making healthcare accessible to the needy.
- **Educational Infrastructure Support:**
 - Creation of a **Happy School** in Muzaffarnagar, offering a joyful and supportive learning environment for children.
 - Donation of **furniture, almirahs, and other essential items** to a government primary school in Muzaffarnagar, enhancing its infrastructure.

These initiatives are a testament to the Club's dedication to long-term community development and its role as a catalyst for positive change in society.
