Donation Of Air Cooler

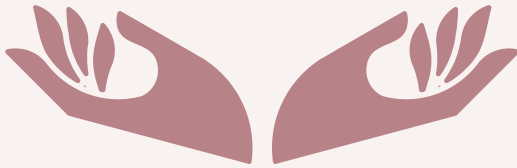
